CX5538 Azure Jakarta	1 1/8 yards	(48) 5 ½" squares
DC5720 Azure Starlettes	5/8 yard	(92) 3" squares
DC5718 Blue Little Spots	3/4 yard	(100) 3" squares
CX3584 Blue Clown Stripe	1/4 yard	(2) 1 ½" x 63 ½" * (2) 1 ½" x 45 ½" *
CX5554 Azure Kota	1/2 yard	(2) 2 ½" x 75 ½" * (2) 2 ½" x 59 ½" *
K1161 (Medium Blue) Krystal	5/8 yard	(7) 2 ½" x W.O.F. * - binding

* Pieced for length

Also Needed: 65" x 85" batting, 65" x 85" backing, thread to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. For one 5 ½" block place one 3" square right sides together aligned with the left corner of one CX5538 5 ½" square. Draw a diagonal line from the lower left corner to the upper right corner of the 3" square. Sew along the drawn line. Trim away excess to ¼" seam. Press corner open. Make (44) blocks with (2) DC5720 3" squares and (2) DC5718 3" squares on each as shown. Make (4) corner blocks with (1) DC5720 3" square and (3) DC5718 3" squares. Set aside.
- 2. Sew one CX3584 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " * strip to each side of the CX5738 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " panel. Sew one CX3584 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " * strip to the top and bottom.
- 3. Sew together (13) 5 ½" blocks matching the DC5720 and DC5718 sides as shown. Make (2). Sew one strip to each side of the quilt with the DC5720 next to the CX3584 border. Refer to the photo.
- 4. Sew together (9) 5 ½" blocks maintaining the pattern in Step #3. Make (2). Sew one 5 ½" square corner block to each end of each row maintaining the pattern established. Sew one strip to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt as shown.
- 5. Sew one CX5554 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ " * strip to each side of the quilt. Sew one CX5554 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ " * strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 6. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 7. Quilt as desired.
- 8. Bind quilt using K1161 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.
