SC5333 Bright White Cotton Couture	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards	(2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (6) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (14) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "	(28) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (5) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x W.O.F. –binding
SC5333 Breeze Cotton Couture	(1) fat 1/8 or 5" x 23" piece each	(5) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of each color

Also needed: 45" x 60" backing, 45" x 60" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

1. For the block rows begin and end with a White 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Alternate (5) random Blue 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares with White 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces to make a 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Using all the blue squares (35) make (7) rows of (5) blue squares each.
2. To assemble the quilt top sew a block strip to the bottom of a White 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece.
3. Alternate White 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces with block rows. Ending with a block row.
4. Complete quilt top by sewing the remaining White 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the bottom of the quilt.
5. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
6. Quilt as desired.
7. Bind quilt using White 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips pieced as needed for length.
