## Materials

## Also Needed:

$50^{\prime \prime} \times 50^{\prime \prime}$ backing, $50^{\prime \prime} \times 50^{\prime \prime}$ batting, threads to match, scissors, straightpins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler.

## Directions

Use 1/4" seam allowance and press all seams open unless otherwise directed

1. For each bear feet unit you will need an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of coordinating print and (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ White squares.
2. Place a print square and a background square right sides together. Lightly mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white fabric.
3. Stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on either side of the marked line. Cut on the line to produce (2) Half-Square Triangle units. Press seams open.

4. Repeat this method with the other set of $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
5. Square up each Half-Square Triangle unit to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
6. Assemble block as shown.
7. Repeat this process for each block.

8. Sew a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip to either side of the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Navy crosshatch square.
9. Lay out blocks as shown in the diagram. Sew a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip between the green and pink bear feet. Sew another sashing strip between the yellow and turquoise bear feet.
10. Sew the two bear feet sections together with the pieced sashing section between them making sure the navy square is in the center of all four blocks.
11. Attach the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 281 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white border strips to the sides of the quilt. Press. Attach the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom. Press.
12. Attach the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ hexo border strips to the quilt sides. Press. Attach the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ hexo border strips to the quilt top and bottom.
13. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste.
14. Quilt as desired.
15. Join together binding strips end-to end. Bind.
