Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions:

- 1. Sew one CM0376 Hollyberry 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the top and bottom of the CX6341 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece. Sew one CM0376 Hollyberry 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to each side set aside.
- 2. For stripped border sew together in order one each of fabrics "A, B, C, D, & E". Make (3) sets. Sew the sets together to make one 26 ¼" x W.O.F. piece. Cut 4 ½" wide pieces across the strip set. Piece the 4 ½" strips together to make (2) 4 ½" x 32 ½" pieces. Sew to each side of the center panel. Make (2) 4 ½" x 26 ½" pieces. Sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt. (Extra pieced fabric will be left over. Use in another project).
- 3. Sew one CM0376 Hollyberry 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to each side of the panel. Sew one CM0376 Hollyberry 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the top and bottom of the panel.
- 4. Sew one CJ3059 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" piece to each side of the quilt. Sew one CJ3059 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" piece to the top and bottom. Set quilt aside.
- 5. Trace pattern pieces onto the paper side of the fusible web. Rough cut out. Following manufacturer's directions, iron pattern pieces onto the following fabrics:

K1149 – (5) small petals, (5) medium small, (5) medium, (4) large K2149– (4) small petals, (2) medium small, (3) medium, (2) large CX4834 Cherry– (2) small petals, (3) medium small, (3) medium, (2) large CX1065 Cherry– (2) small petals, (3) medium small, (2) medium, (2) large CX1065 Olive– (4) small leaves, (5) medium small, (4) medium, (5) large K1156– (4) small leaves, (4) medium small, (4) medium, (2) large CX4834 Lime– (1) each of (3) flower centers

Cut out all leaves/petals and flower centers. Remove paper backing. Arrange the poinsettias as shown or as desired. The top flower has (14) petals and (9) leaves. The middle flower has (15) petals and (9) leaves. The bottom flower has (20) petals and (14) leaves. Fuse in place. Using matching thread, machine satin stitch around each petal/leaf adding a center vein to finish. Add the flower center and machine satin stitch in place.

Pro tip: Iron-on tear-away stabilizer on the back of the quilt by doing the applique. It will make the stitching easier and more even. Remove all stabilizer after stitching.

- 6. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 7. Quilt as desired.
- 8. Bind quilt using K2257 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.
- 9. With a hand sewing needle sew (7) assorted jingle bells in the top and middle flowers and (8) bells in the bottom flower. Enjoy!
