Materials

Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	PC6313-Seafoam Tile Pile	1 ¼ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut six 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fifty-four 4 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
(B)	SC5333-Spa Cotton Couture	1 ¼ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut six 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fifty-four 4 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
(C)	PC6292-Canary Petal Garland	1 ¾ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut two 2 ½" x 54 ½" strips from the length of fabric (LOF), each centered on a vine. • Cut two 2 ½" x 48 ½" LOF strips, each centered on a vine.
(D)	SC5333-Bright White Cotton Couture	1 yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut three 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 1 ½" x 58 ½" strips. • Cut three 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 1 ½" x 54 ½" strips. • See instructions to cut three large circles. • See instructions to cut two medium circles.
(E)	PC6291-Canary Petal Pinwheels	1 ¾ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut two 5 ½" x 60 ½" LOF strips. • Cut two 5 ½" x 54 ½" LOF strips.
(F)	PC6313-Gray Tile Pile	⅓ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut one 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 5 ½" squares and four 2 ½" squares. • See instructions to eight small petals for the small flowers.
(G)	PC6314-Multi Pegs A'Plenty	¼ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instructions to cut eight large petals for the large flowers. • See instructions to cut two small flower centers.
(H)	PC6313-Multi Tile Pile	⅞ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instructions to cut eight large petals for the small flowers. • See instructions to cut three large flower centers. • Cut seven 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
(I)	SC5333-Mango Cotton Couture	¼ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instructions to cut eight small petals for the large flowers.
(J)	SC5333-Coral Cotton Couture	¼ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instructions to cut eight large petals for the large flowers.
(K)	SC5333-Candlelight Cotton Couture	¼ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instructions to cut eight large petals for the small flowers. • See instructions to cut four small petals for the large flowers.
(L)	PC6313-Coral Tile Pile	¼ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instructions to cut four large petals for the large flowers.

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(M)	SC5333-Canary Cotton Couture	¼ yard	• See instructions to cut four large petals for the large flowers.
(N)	SC5333-Kryptonite Cotton Couture	¾ yard	• Cut one 1" x 37" strip. • Cut one 1" x 30" strip. • Cut one 1" x 24" strip. • Cut one 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into one 1" x 18" strip and one 1" x 14" strip. (Add fusible web to the back of the fabric before cutting) • See instructions to cut seven leaves.
Backing	PC6314-Multi Pegs A'Plenty	4 yards	• Cut two 72" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 78" pieced backing.

You will also need:

• 72" x 78" batting, 4 yards of fusible web, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Blocks Assembly

1. Sew six 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric A strips and six 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strips together along the 6 ½" sides, alternating them to make one row. Repeat to make nine rows.
2. Sew the nine rows together alternating which fabric begins the row to complete the background block (Fig. 1).
3. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about ⅛" outside the drawn lines.
4. For the large circles, press fusible web to the back of the remaining Fabric D fabric. Cut three 13" squares and two 11" squares.









5. Fold each square into quarters with the fusible web side out. Cut out and align the $\frac{1}{4}$ circle template on each folded square, aligning the folded edge with the marked template. Trace the $\frac{1}{4}$ circle onto fusible web. Cut out the $\frac{1}{4}$ circle through all the layers to make three 12" diameter circles and two 10" diameter circles.
6. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
7. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press large flowers, two small flowers, five Fabric N strips and seven leaves onto the background block to complete the center block.
8. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.

Quilt Top Assembly



(Follow Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

9. Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the center block.
10. Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
11. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
12. Sew one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top.
13. Sew one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the seven 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric H strips together, end-to-end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
16. Bind as desired.










