Backing \& Batting: 55" x 67"

Quilt by Heidi Pridemore
Size: Approximately 47" x 59" Skill Level: Intermediate

## Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.
Fabric Yardage Cutting

| (A) | CX6492-Lagoon* <br> Ricky - Lagoon | 2 yards | - Cut two $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. <br> - Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 511 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from the length of fabric (LOF). <br> - Cut three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from the remaining fabric. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 471 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |

| (B) | CX6358-Lime Tiny Trucks - Lime | $1 / 4$ yard | - Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twentyfour $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| (C) | CX4835-Charcoal <br> Tiny Houndstooth - Charcoal | 1 yard | - Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fortyeight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. <br> - See instructions to cut three raccoon tails, heads, bodies and legs. <br> - See instructions to cut six eye patches. <br> - Cut six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding. |
| (D) | CX6363-Mermaid Everyday Houndstooth Mermaid | $3 / 8$ yard | - Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fortyeight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| (E) | CX6360-Caribe Argyle Me - Caribe | $1 / 3$ yard | - Cut two 2 " x $391 / 2$ " strips. <br> - Cut three 2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 2" x $481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| (F) | CX4835-Calypso <br> Tiny Houndstooth - Calypso | 3/4 yard | - See instructions to cut three raccoon bodies, heads, tails, and legs. <br> - See instructions to cut six eye patches. |
| (G) | CX6358-Teal* Tiny Trucks - Teal | 2/3 yard | - Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. <br> - Cut one $121 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| (H) | Plain White | 7/8 yard | - Cut two $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. <br> - Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twentyfour $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. <br> - See instructions to cut raccoon eyes and ears. |
| (I) | Plain Black | $1 / 4$ yard | - See instructions to cut raccoon accents. |
| Bac | CX6493-Lagoon Big Time Houndstooth Lagoon | $31 / 4$ yards | - Cut two 55 " $\times$ WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 55 " x 67 " pieced backing. |

## * Fabric is directional

## You will also need:

- $55^{\prime \prime} \times 67^{\prime \prime}$ batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.


## Disclaimers

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Block Assembly

1. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to each side of one $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H square. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric H square.
2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
3. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
4. Refer to the quilt layout to arrange and press the three Fabric $C$ raccoons and three Fabric $F$ raccoons and their accents onto the six Fabric H blocks from Step 1.
5. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete six Raccoon Blocks.
6. Place one $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the left side of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
7. Place another $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ square on the right side of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make one DHD unit.

8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make twenty-four DHD units total.
9. Sew one $21 / 2$ " Fabric C square to each end of one DHD unit to make one side border. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew one side border to each side of one $81 / 2$ " Fabric A square.
10. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ square to each end of one DHD strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square to complete one Block Two (Fig. 5).

## Quilt Top Assembly (Follow Quilt layout while assembling the quilt top.)

12. Sew two Block Ones and one Block Two together to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
13. Sew two Block Twos and one Block One together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
14. Sew the four rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
15. Sew 2 " $\times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $2 " \times 391 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
16. Sew one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " Fabric A strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 471 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
17. Layer and quilt as desired.
18. Sew the six $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end-to-end with $45^{\circ}$ seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
19. Bind as desired.
