

SC5333 Lime Cotton Couture	¼ yard	(1) 3 ½" x 30 ½" (1) 5 ½" x 30 ½" (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" (1) 2 ½" square (1) 4" x 8"
SC5333 Luna Cotton Couture	¼ yard	(2) 2 ½" x 13 ½" (3) 3 ½" square (2) 3 ½" x 7 ½" (2) 2 ½" x 3 ½" (2) 3 ½" x 5 ½" (1) 5 ½" x 13 ½" (1) 4 ½" x 13 ½"

Also Needed:

45" X 60" backing, 45" x 60" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, and mat.

** Or amount required to get one complete repeat of the motif.

^{*} NOTE: There are two corners which require pivoting the seam. They are clearly marked and easy to follow the directions.

directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.


Directions

- 1. Section 'A' sew one 2 ½" x 9 ½" Tangerine piece to the top of PC6309 3 ½" x 9 ½" piece. Sew one 6 ½" x 9 ½" Tangerine piece to the bottom of the PC6309 piece. Sew one 2 ½" x 3 ½" Tangerine piece to the bottom of one PC6309 3 ½" square. Sew one 5 ½" Tangerine square to the left side of the unit and one 1 ½" x 5 ½" Tangerine piece to the right side. Sew completed unit to the bottom of the 6 ½" x 9 ½" piece. Set aside section 'A'.
- 2. Section 'B' Sew one 3 ½" x 5 ½" Luna piece to the top and bottom of one PC6309 3 ½" square. Sew one 5 ½" x 13 ½" Luna piece to the right side of the pieced strip. Sew one 2 ½" x 3 ½" Luna piece to the left side of one PC6309 3 ½" square. Sew one 3 ½" Luna square to the right side of the unit. Sew the unit to the bottom of the 8 ½" x 13 ½" piece. Sew completed section 'B' to the right side of section 'A'. Set aside.
- 3. Section 'C' Sew one 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Royal square to the top of one PC6309 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Royal piece to the right side of the unit. Sew completed section 'C' to the right side of section 'B'. Set aside.
- 4. Section 'D' Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Lime piece to the left end of one PC6309 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece. Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Lime square to the right end of the PC6309 piece. Sew one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Lime piece to the top of the pieced strip. Sew one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Lime piece to the bottom of the PC6309 piece. Sew completed section 'D' to the bottom of the 'A/B/C' unit. Set aside.
- 5. Section 'E' Sew one 3 ½" Tangerine square to the left side of one PC6309 3 ½" square. Sew one 3 ½" x 4 ½" Tangerine piece to the right side. Sew one Tangerine 4 ½" x 10 ½" piece to the top of the pieced strip and one Tangerine 6 ½" x 10 ½" piece to the bottom. Sew one Tangerine 5 ½" x 20 ½" piece to the left side of one PC6309 5 ½" x 20 ½" piece. Sew strip to the bottom of the 10 ½" x 13 ½" unit. Sew section 'E' to the right side of the 'A/B/C/D' unit to within ¼" of the edge of the bottom Lime piece ('X' on the diagram). Set aside.
- 6. Section 'F' Sew one 5 ½" x 25 ¼" Royal piece to the right side of the PC6309 22 ½" W x 25 ¼" H piece. Sew one Lime 4" x 8" piece to the upper right corner of the PC6309 piece as shown in the diagram. Leave the bottom ¼" seam allowance unsewn. This is the second pivot seam. Sew the top of the unit to the quilt.

 Join the remainder of the Lime 4" x 8" piece to the left side bottom of section 'E'.
- 7. Section 'G' Sew one 3 ½" Luna square and one 3 ½" x 7 ½" Luna piece to each end of one PC6309 3 ½" square. Make (2). Sew together with a 3 ½" Luna square on the left end and one on the right end. Sew one 4 ½" x 13 ½" Luna piece to the top of the pieced unit and one 2 ½" x 13 ½" Luna piece to the bottom. Sew one 3 ½" x 4 ½" Luna piece to the left side of one PC6309 3 ½" x 7 ½". Sew one 3 ½" x 2 ½" Luna piece to the right side. Sew one 2 ½" x 13 ½" Luna piece to the bottom of the strip. Sew the completed unit to the bottom of the 12 ½" x 13 ½" Luna section. Sew the top of section 'G' to the bottom of section 'E/F' as shown on the diagram. Sew remaining seam on section 'G' to the right side of PC6309 22 ½" x 25 ¼" piece.
- 8. Sew one 6 ½" x 40 ½" Royal piece to the bottom of the guilt.
- 9. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 10. Quilt as desired.
- 11. Bind quilt using Royal 2 ½" strips pieced as needed for length.
