ROLL022 - (40) - 2 1/2" X 44" STRIPS (6/CASE)

FQ071 - (20) - FAT QUARTER BUNDLE (3/CASE)

QUILT BY HEIDI PRIDEMORE
SKILL LEVEL: ADVANCED BEGINNER

SIZE: Approximately 52" X 68"

NOTE: Our design used a matching **SQUARE019** and **ROLL022**

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE NOTE: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.

	FABRIC	YARDAGE	CUTTING
SQUARE	SQUARE019 (12/CASE)	1 PACK= (42) 10" SQUARES	FROM 10" SQUARES: _Cut a total of (96) 4 7/8" squares from assorted colors.
ROLL	ROLL021 (12/CASE)	1 PACKS= (40) 2 1/2 X WOF STRIPS	FROM 2 1/2" STRIPS: _Cut a total of (512) 2 1/2" squares from assorted colors.
BINDING	YOUR CHOICE	1 YARD	_Cut seven 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and cut two 2 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips. _Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
BACKING	YOUR CHOICE	3 1/2 YARD	_Cut two 60" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 60" x 76" pieced backing.

YOU WILL ALSO NEED: 60" x 76" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Quilt Assembly

1. Select four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for each 4-patch block, you will need ninety-six sets. Sew each set into a 4-patch block (Fig. 1).

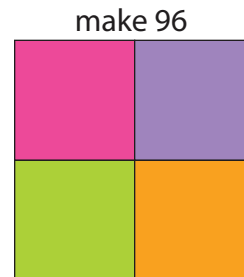

2. Pair up two $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares for half-square triangle blocks. You will need forty-eight sets total.

3. Place one $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square on top of another $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2).

4. Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make two half-square triangles (Fig. 4). Trim blocks to measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

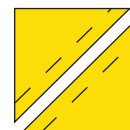

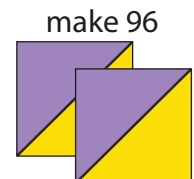

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 with the remaining sets of $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares to make a total of ninety-six half-square triangle blocks total.

6. Follow Figure 5 to sew together eight 4-patch squares and eight half-square triangle squares to make one $16\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make twelve $16\frac{1}{2}$ " squares total

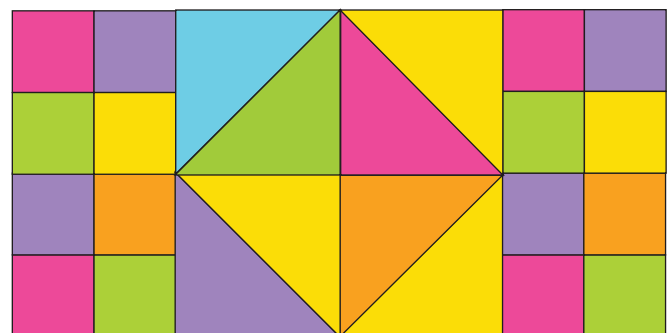

Quilt Top Assembly

7. Sew the blocks into four rows with three blocks in each row.
8. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.
9. Sew one 2 ½" x 64 ½" border stripe to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 ½" x 52 ½" border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
12. Bind as desired.
