Backi	ing CM0376-Avocado)	3 yards	Cut two 52" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 52" x 60" pieced backing.	

#### You will also need:

• 52" x 60" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

#### **Block Assembly**

- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Select two stars, one circle and one 8 ½" square of different colors.
- 4. Press the two stars and one circle together onto the 8 ½" square in assorted color combos as desired.
- 5. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete one block.
- 6. Repeat to make thirty blocks, using the remaining stars, circles and 8 ½" squares in assorted color combinations.

#### Quilt Top Assembly (Follow Quilt Photo while assembling the quilt top.)

- 7. Lay out the blocks in six rows, with five blocks in each row, to decide on block placement.
- 8. Sew the blocks together into rows. Sew the six rows together to make the guilt top.
- 9. Sew one 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric P strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric P strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Layer and quilt as desired.
- 11. Sew the five 2 ½" x WOF Fabric P strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
- 12. Bind as desired.

### Templates
