Also Needed: $45^{\prime \prime} \times 60^{\prime \prime}$ backing, $45^{\prime \prime} \times 60^{\prime \prime}$ batting, threads to match scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, mat, (1) skein 6-strand cotton embroidery floss - Navy Blue, (1) embroidery or crewel handsewing needle, water soluble fabric marker, and fusible web. OPTIONAL (but recommended): iron-on tear-away stablilzer

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Directions:

1. Following manufacturer's directions, trace pattern pieces onto the paper side of the fusible web. Rough cut out each piece. Iron each pattern piece on the wrong side of each designated fabric on the pattern pieces. Cut out each piece on the pattern lines.
2. Arrange pattern pieces as shown on SC5333 $221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 371 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Remove paper backing and iron each pattern piece in place as shown. Iron fusible web onto the back of each of the three CX6353 flowers. Cut out. Remove paper and fuse in place as shown. Machine satin stich all raw edges to finish using matching threads.
3. Sew one CX5916 $1^{\prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and bottom of the SC5333 panel. Sew one CX5916 1" x $381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to each side.
4. Sew one CX6353 $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 331 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to each side of the quilt. Sew one CX6353 $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 331 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and bottom.
5. Sew one CX3584 $1^{\prime \prime} \times 331 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one CX3584 $1^{\prime \prime} \times 491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece (pieced for length) to each side.
6. Refer to the photo for suggested placement - sew together assorted $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border pieces to make (2) 3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. Sew one to the top and bottom of the quilt. Piece together the remaining $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces to make (2) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 551 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. Sew one strip to each side.
7. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
8. Quilt as desired.
9. Using the water soluble pen, free hand draw vines and leaves onto the background of SC5333 as shown.
10. Using 3 strands separated out from the 6-strand cotton embroidery floss in the embroidery (or crewal) needle stitch the drawn lines using a running stitch. Stitch through all layers of the quilt as shown. Remove all traces of the water soluble pen lines.
11. Bind quilting using CX5916 $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips pieced as needed for length.
