Fabric C - 1/2 yard	CX6713 Lilac Eduardo	2" x 41 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric D - 1/2 yard	CX6713 Rose Eduardo	2" x 41 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric E - 1/2 yard	CX6713 Krytopnite Eduardo	2" x 41 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric F - 1/2 yard	CX6713 Coin Eduardo	2" x 41 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric G - 1/4 yard	SC5333 Magenta Cotton Couture	1" x 41 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric H - 1/4 yard	CX6718 Grape Emilia	3 1/2" x 41 1/2" two pieces, one for each sid
Fabric I - 1/4 yard	SC5333 Magenta Cotton Couture	1" x 32 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric J - 1/4 yard	CX6718 Grape Emilia	1" x 32 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric K - 1/4 yard	SC5333 Limeade Cotton Couture	1" x 32 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric L - 1/4 yard	SC5333 Limeade *** Cotton Couture	1" x 49 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric M - 1/2 yard	CX6719 Grape Ernesta	5" x 33 1/2" two pieces, one for each side.
Fabric N - 1/2 yard	CX6719 Grape Ernesta ***	$5'' \times 59 1/2''$ two pieces, one for each side.
Binding - 1/2 yard	SC5333 Luna Cotton Couture	
Backing - 1 3/4 yards	CX6720 Grape Elena	

*** (Use 3 strips, 5" x 44" split the third strip

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions:

This quilt is super easy and fun to construct. The image is the sample layout for the entire project. The letters represent the order of operations for both sides of the quilt as well as show the CUT sizes for the pieces.

I usually cut my strips 44" x the listed widths. I remove both selvedges, then sew the strip into place. I then trim the strip to the correct size by squaring the newly added piece to the rest of the quilt.

I do recommend the same piecing format as the measurements provided have been taken from the finished quilt but is not how it was constructed.
