Color 8 - Cotton Couture Color Lipstick - 1/4 Yard
Color 9 - Cotton Couture Color Clementine - 1/4 Yard
Color 10 - Cotton Couture color Apricot - 1/4 Yard
Color 11 - Cotton Couture Color Tangerine - 1/4 Yard

The image to the left is the sample layout for all the strips and strata used in my project, but do as you like, the possibilities are endless.

## Make your Strata

1. Make strips of each fabric that measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Cut your strips to 22 "
3. Take two of the 22 " strips and split each one of them into $22^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{\prime \prime}$ and $22^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ so that you now have two each that measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $1^{\prime \prime}$ 4. Make your sets, keep your color order the same but make several sets of strata. First make strata using all the same sizes, then for the next strata sets, mix the sizes of strips, but keep the color order the same.

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The key is to keep it looking random!
