



## **Materials**

## **Cutting instructions**

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	PC6625-Pink Floating with the Fishes – Pink	1 ⅓ yards	• Cut two 8 ½" x 63 ½" strips from the length of fabric (LOF).
(B)	PC6620-Coral A Sea of Stars – Coral	⅓ yard	• Cut two 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut one 5 ½" x 63 ½" strip.
(C)	PC6621-Citrus Umbrella Stripe – Citrus	⅓ yard	<ul> <li>Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 63 ½" strips.</li> </ul>
(D)	PC6623-Pink New Wave – Pink	½ yard	<ul> <li>Cut eight 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut four 2" x 63 ½" strips.</li> </ul>
(E)	PC6624-Pink Meetin at the Reef – Pink	¼ yard	• Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into ten 3 ½" squares.
(F)	PC6620-Yellow A Sea of Stars – Yellow	¼ yard	<ul> <li>Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 ½" squares.</li> </ul>
(G)	PC6619-Citrus Dozens of Dollars – Citrus	¼ yard	<ul> <li>Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 ½" squares.</li> </ul>
(H)	PC6618-Fern Little Diggers – Fern	¾ yard	<ul> <li>Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 ½" squares.</li> <li>Cut seven 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.</li> </ul>
(1)	PC6623-Mango New Wave – Mango	¼ yard	• Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 ½" squares.
(J)	PC6618-Raspberry Little Diggers – Raspberry	⅓ yard	<ul> <li>Cut four 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 3 ½" x 63 ½" strips.</li> <li>Cut three 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 3 ½" x 54 ½" strips.</li> </ul>
(K)	SC5333-White Cotton Couture – White	1 yard	<ul> <li>Cut one 9 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 3 ½" x 9 ½" strips and four 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips</li> <li>Cut one 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.</li> <li>Cut three 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-four 3 ½" squares.</li> </ul>
Back	ring PC6616-Magenta Swimming in the Sea – Magenta	3 ½ yards	<ul> <li>Cut two 62" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 77" pieced backing.</li> </ul>

## You will also need:

• 62" x 77" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.



While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

### **Block Assembly**


- 1. Sew one 3 ½" Fabric E square, one 3 ½" Fabric F square, one 3 ½" Fabric G square, two 3 ½" Fabric K squares and two 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric K strips together to make one Block One (Fig. 1).
- 2. Repeat Step 1 using assorted 3 ½" squares, two 3 ½" Fabric K squares and two 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric K strips to make eight Block Ones.
- 3. Sew three assorted 3 ½" squares, three 3 ½" Fabric K squares and one 3 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric K strip together to make one Block Two (Fig. 2). Repeat to make six Block Twos total.



# **Quilt Top Assembly**

# (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 4. Sew one 2" x 63 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of one 8 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric A strip to make Column One. Repeat to make Column Five.
- 5. Sew four Block Ones and three Block Twos together to make Column Two. Repeat to make Column Four.
- 6. Sew one 2" x 63 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of one 5 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric B strip to make Column Three.
- 7. Sew the five columns together, in numerical order, to make the guilt top.
- 8. Sew one 3 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 9. Layer and guilt as desired.
- 10. Sew the seven 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
- 11. Bind as desired.



Quilt Layout
