Materials

Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	PC6624-Seafoam Meeting at the Reef – Seafoam	¾ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut two 12 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into five 10 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
(B)	SC5333-Coral Cotton Couture – Coral	½ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut one 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twenty 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips and four 1 ½" squares.
(C)	PC6620-Wave Sea of Stars – Wave	1 yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut one 14 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into ten 3 ½" x 14 ½" strips. • Cut one 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into ten 3 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
(D)	PC6618-Coral Little Diggers – Coral	1 ⅛ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut one 14 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 ½" x 14 ½" strips. • Cut one 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 ½" x 12 ½" strips. • Cut two 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty 3 ½" squares.
(E)	PC6625-Wave Floatin with the Fishes – Wave	½ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut one 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 10 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
(F)	PC6623-Citron New Wave – Citron	⅔ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut one 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips. • Cut three 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
(G)	PC6620-Seafoam Sea of Stars – Seafoam	1 ⅛ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 4 ½" x 68 ½" strips. • Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 4 ½" x 62 ½" strips.
(H)	PC6617-Straw Little Fishes – Straw	⅓ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut two 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 3 ½" squares.
(I)	PC6622-Wave Sea Coral – Wave	1 ½ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut six 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 2" x 20 ½" strips. • Cut eight 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut four 2" x 60 ½" strips. • Cut eight 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
(J)	PC6621-Wave Umbrella Stripe – Wave	¾ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut four 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 1 ½" x 66 ½" strips. • Cut four 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
(K)	PC6619-Wave Dozens of Dollars – Wave	¼ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut one 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 4 ½" squares.
Backing	PC6618-Turq. Little Diggers – Turq.	4 ½ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut two 78" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 78" x 84" pieced backing.

You will also need:

- 78" x 84" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

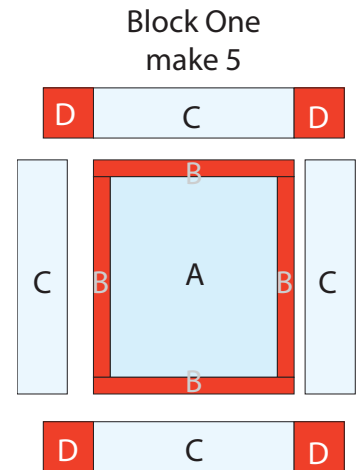
Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Block Assembly

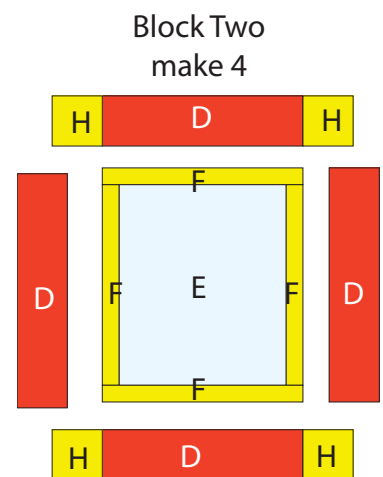
1. Sew one 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of one 10 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew one 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make one Block One center. Repeat to make five Block One centers total.

2. Sew one 3 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of one Block One center. Sew one 3 ½" Fabric D square to each end of one 3 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Block One center to make one Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make five Block Ones total.



3. Sew one 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of one 10 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip. Sew one 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make one Block Two center. Repeat to make five Block Two centers total.

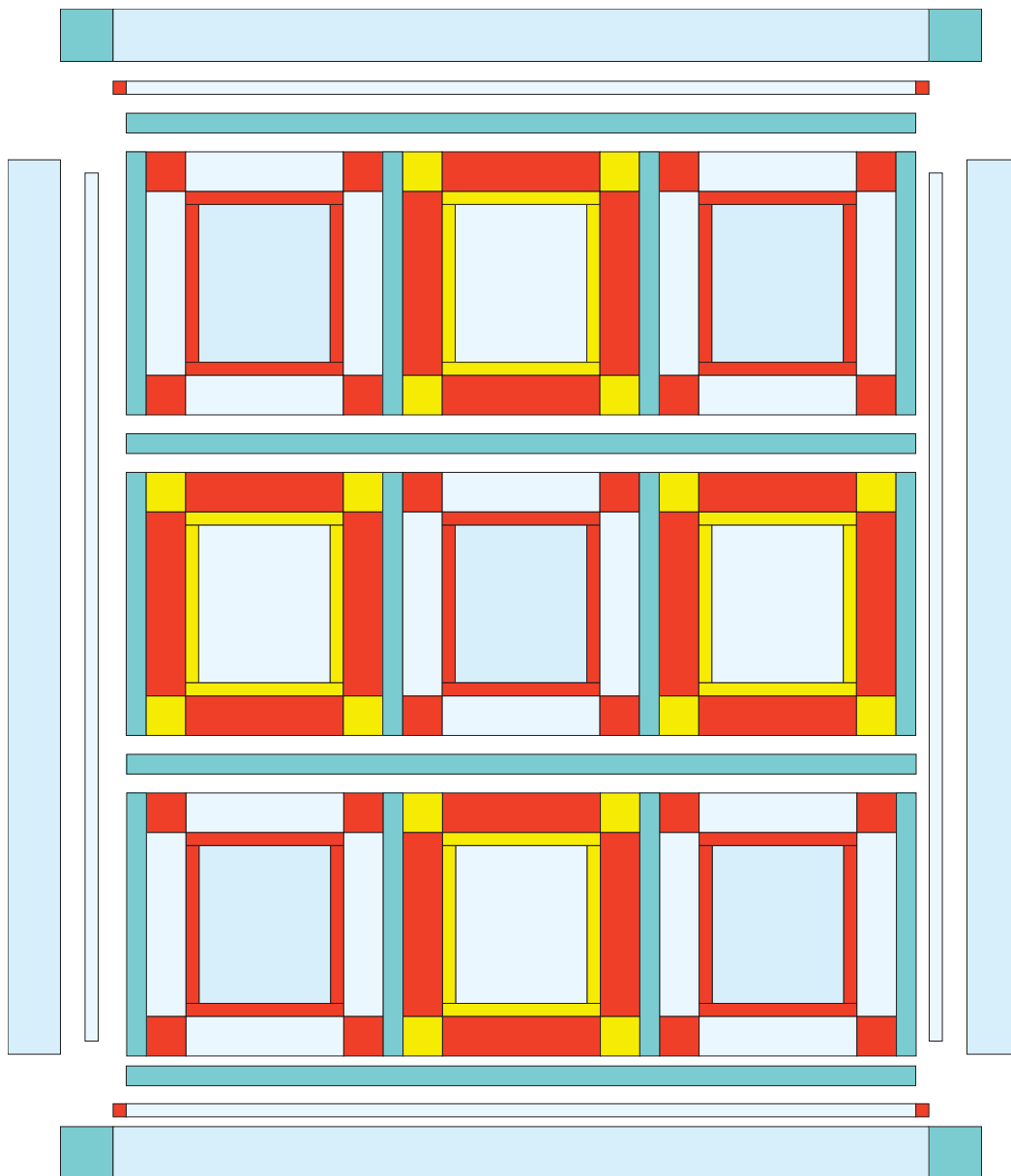
4. Sew one 3 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of one Block Two center. Sew one 3 ½" Fabric H square to each end of one 3 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Block Two center to make one Block Two (Fig. 2). Repeat to make four Block Twos total.



Quilt Top Assembly (*Follow Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.*)

5. Sew four 2" x 20 ½" Fabric I strips, two Block Ones and one Block Two together to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
6. Sew four 2" x 20 ½" Fabric I strips, two Block Twos and one Block One together to make Row Two.
7. Sew the three rows and four 2" x 60 ½" Fabric I strips together to make the quilt top.

8. Sew one 1 ½" x 66 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1 ½" Fabric B square to each end of one 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric J strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
9. Sew one 4 ½" x 68 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4 ½" Fabric K square to each end of one 4 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the eight 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end-to-end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
12. Bind as desired.



Quilt Layout
