## Also Needed:

$46 " \times 54$ " backing, $46^{\prime \prime} \times 54$ " batting, threads to match, scissors, straightpins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler.

The enclosed directions were used in the the construction of the original quilt.

Directions:
Use $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance and press all seams open unless otherwise directed

Flying Geese Blocks:

1. Place a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Charcoal square on top of a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Magenta piece, Right sides together.

2. Sew a diagonal line from corner to corner on the Charcoal square as shown.
3. Trim excess charcoal fabric leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press fabric open.

4. Repeat this process on the other side completing a Flying Geese unit.

5. Continue making Flying Geese units for each $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric piece in each color. You will have 21 total Flying Geese units.

Bordered Blocks
6. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Stripe fabric strip to opposite sides of an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Blue Flower fabric.

7. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Stripe fabric strip to the remaining sides of the Blue Flower fabric. Make 3 Bordered Blocks.


Quilt Assembly:
SECTION 1
8. Begin by piecing together Flying Geese blocks in the order shown for section 1.
9. Sew an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Dot fabric to the top of a Bordered Block. Sew this unit to the right side of the Flying Geese unit.
10. Attach an 8 1/2" x 20 1/2" Pink Flower fabric to the bottom to complete SECTION 1.

## SECTION 2

11. Sew together the Flying Geese blocks in the order shown for section 2.
12. Attach the $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ 1/2" Dot fabric to the bottom of the Flying Geese unit to complete SECTION 2.

SECTION 3
13. Join the $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Pink Flower fabric lengthwise to the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Stripe fabric.
14. Attach a Bordered Block to the bottom of the unit as shown in the diagram to complete SECTION 3.
15. Sew sections 1-3 together to complete the top half of the quilt top.

## SECTION 4

16. Sew together the Flying Geeses blocks in the order shown for section 4.
17. Join the $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Pink Flower fabric lengthwise to the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Stripe fabric.
18. Attach a Bordered Block to the end of the Flower/Stripe unit as shown.
19. Finish by attaching the Flying Geese unit to complete SECTION 4.

SECTION 5
20. Sew together the Flying Geeses blocks in the order shown for section 5.
21. Attach ther Flying Geese unit lengthwise to the remaining $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Pink Flower fabric to complete Section 5.
22. Join sections 4 and 5 to complete the bottom half of the quilt top.
23. Join the top half and bottom half to finish the quilt.
24. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste.
25. Quilt as desired.
26. Join together binding strips end-to end. Bind.
