Also Needed: 45" x 60" backing, 45" x 60" batting, thread to match (including black, pink, and white), scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, fusible web, iron-on tear-away stabilizer, chalk pencil, and mat.

* Cut $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from top edge of loop motif. Measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from cut top edge across the border motif to cut. Refer to photo.
** Cut $1 / 4$ from bottom edge of loop motif. Measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from cut bottom edge across the border motif to cut. Refer to photo.

NOTE: There will be extra fabric leftover from the border prints. It can be pieced for the quilt backing or saved for another project.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Directions:

From the top sew together in the following order. The 18 1/2" long strips: CX6552 Red - $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, CX5456 Ebony - 2", PC6748-3 1/2"', PC6749 White - 4"'PC6747 Gray - $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, CX5456 Ebony - 2 1/2", CX6552 2 1/2"', CX5456 Ebony - 2", PC6748-3 1/2", CX'6552 Red - 2 1/2", PC6'749 White - 4"' CX6552'Black - 2 1/2", ĆX5456 Ebony-2 1/2", and PC6747 'Gray-3 1/2" to make an $181 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece.

Sew one CX5456 Black $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and bottom of the panel. Sew one CX5456 Black $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to each side. Set aside.

Trace cut head, nose, and ears onto the paper side of the fusible web. Rough Cut out. Following manufacturers directions iron cat head onto the wrong side of SC5333 Black. Iron nose and ears onto the wrong side of SC5333 Flower. Cut out all pieces. Remove paper backing from ears and nose. Iron into place on the cat head as shown. Machine applique in place. Transfer whisker, eyes, mouth, and other markings onto the right side of the cat face. Machine satin stitch in white to finish. Remove paper backing. Iron cat head onto the pieced panel as shown (or as desired). Machine applique in place. Set aside.

For the left side border - Sew one CX5456 Black $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side of PC6747 Aqua $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Sew one PC6747 Gray $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the other side of the CX5456 Black strip. Align edge of PC6747 White with the top edge of the pieced panel. Sew border panel to the pieced panel to within $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ of the bottom edge. The PC6747 Gray border will extend beyond the edge for $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. This will be finished later.

For the top border - sew one CX5456 Black $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side of one PC6747 Aqua $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Sew one PC6747 White $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 231 / 2$ piece to the right side of the CX5456 Black strip. Align the left side of the panel with the top edge of the quilt. Sew border panel onto the top of the pieced panel to within $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ of the right side edge. The PC6747 White border will extend beyond the edge for $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. This will be finished later.

For the right side border - Sew one CX5456 Black $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side of one PC6747 White $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 291 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Sew one PC6747 Aqua $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the right side of the CX5456 Black strip. Align the edge of the PC6747 Aqua end of the border panel with the bottom edge of the pieced strip. Sew border panel to within $1 / 4$ "of the top right corner of the pieced panel. The PC6747 White border panel will extend 10 1/2" beyond the edge. To finish the upper right corner, miter the $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ extended fabric pieces from the top border and the right border as shown. Trim excess fabric from the back.

For the bottom border sew one CX5456 $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the right side of PC6749 Gray 10 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 261 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew one PC6747 Aqua $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the right side of CX5456 Black. Align the right side of the border panel with the edge of the right border panel. Sew in place to with $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ of the left side edge of the pieced panel. To finish the lower left corner, miter the $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ extended fabric pieces from the left border and bottom border as shown. Trim excess as in step \#6. Quilt top should measure 40 1/2" x 56 1/2".
Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
Quilt as desired.
Bind quilt using CX6749 Coral 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.
