Finished Quilt Size: 54" x 65" Skill Level: Beginner

#### Also Needed:

- 58" x 70" quilt batting.

- A rotary cutter, a long acrylic ruler with 45° markings, cutting mat, thread, scissors, pins, pencil.

#### **Cutting Instructions:**


Binding fabric - Cut 6 strips 21/4" x WOF (width of fabrc). Set aside to bind quilt.


All colored fabrics

- Cut pieces accoring to the following tables.
- BRIGHT WHITE
- Cut 16 strips 3" x WOF. From these strips cut 60 (3" x 8¼") rectangles and 60 (3½" x 3") rectangles.
  Cut 2 strips 8½" wide x WOF. Subcut into 10 (8½") squares. Subcut these squares into 90° triangles, cutting corner to opposite corner. Cut 2 of these in half to form 4 smaller 90° triangles (See Fig 1)

\* Subcut each of these squares into two 90° triangles, cutting corner to opposite corner.

All seam allowances are 1/4".


#### **Quilt Layout:**

Lay your 6" squares and 5" triangles out to make 30 blocks, as indicated in fig 2 (refer to quilt photo for color placement).

#### Making Block A:

Each Block A consists of: one 6" colored square and four 5" triangles.


Piece these together as indicated in the following diagram, keeping triangles centred on sides of square. Press seams open. Square up finished block (keeping centre square centred), cutting to exactly 1/4" beyond centre square's corners. Your finished block should measure 8 1/8".



#### Making Block B:

Each **Block B** consists of: one  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " colored square, 2 (3" x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ") white rectangles and 2 (3" x  $8\frac{1}{4}$ ") white rectangles. Piece these together as indicated in the following diagram, pressing seams open.

Square up finished block to 8 1/8", keeping colored square centred. It is important that this block is the same size as **Block A**.



#### **Piecing Quilt Top:**

Insert all 30 **Block B** into quilt layout (Refer to quilt photo for color placement). Add white triangles around edge, keeping the 4 small ones for the corners. Sew squares & triangles together in diagonal rows, pressing all seams open. Sew these rows together, matching seam lines and corners. Refer to **fig. 2** 

#### **Assembling Quilt:**

Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste or pin. Quilt as desired. Square up quilt top, maintaining ¼" fabric beyond **Block B** corners. Join binding strips together and bind in your preferred fashion.
