2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square

Loden
2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square



Nite
2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square

2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square



Gray
2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square



Khaki

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

MATERIALS:

- SC5333 2 1/2" square of each color, fat quarter each of SC5333 Cotton Couture black and charcoal
- Rotary cutting supplies
- Low loft batting
- Marking pen or pencil
- Fabric for backing and binding

Directions:

NOTE: Sew all seams using an exact 1/4" seam allowance

1. In addition to the charm pack, you will need to cut:
 - (9) 2.5" squares of black
 - (11) 2.5" squares of charcoal
 - (2) 1.5" by 15.5" strips of black
 - (2) 1.5" by 13.5" strips of black
2. Cut the following squares in half down the middle, making (2) 1.25" strips:
 - brick
 - cranberry
 - watermelon
 - loden
 - nite
 - midnight
 - gray
 - khaki
 - stone
 - petal
 - olive
 - magenta
 - raspberry
 - amber
 - cinnamon
 - chocolate
 - amethyst
 - turf
 - black
 - gold
 - herb

3. Cut one of the turf strips in half-making (2) 1.25" squares
Cut one of the gray strips in half-making (2) 1.25" squares
4. Cut the 2.5" square of luna into quarters-making (4) 1.25" squares
Cut 2 of the 2.5" squares of black into quarters-making (8) 1.25" squares
5. Lay out the pieces following the color shown in the diagram
Sew row 1 together, pressing seams in the same direction as you go
Sew row 2 together, pressing seams in the opposite direction from row 1
Continue sewing all 9 rows, pressing seams in the opposite direction from the row above
6. Sew the rows together
7. Sew the 1.5" by 13.5" strips to either side of the mini quilt
8. Sew the 1.5" by 15.5" strips to the top and bottom
9. Layer top, batting and backing together and quilt as desired.
