#### **"Fairy Dream"** Quilt by Heidi Pridemore Size: Approximately 55" x 65" Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

### **Materials**

#### **Cutting instructions**

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	DM6797-Blossom Fairy Dream Border – Blossom	2 ½ yards	<ul> <li>Cut one 18 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 28 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip.</li> <li>Cut three 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Piece the white sections together and cut two 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 32 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> <li>Cut two 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 38 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips from the length of fabric (LOF) strips from the white section.</li> </ul>
(B)	DM6799-Pink Fairy Dreamland – Pink	¼ yard	See instructions to cut five butterflies.
(C)	DM6799-Lilac Fairy Dreamland – Lilac	% yard	<ul> <li>Cut five 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 48 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips and two 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> <li>Cut two 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 28 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> <li>Cut two 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 22 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> </ul>
(D)	CM0376-Fancy Fairy Frost – Fancy	¼ yard	<ul><li>See instructions to cut one butterfly.</li><li>See instructions to cut fifteen dots.</li></ul>
(E)	CM0376-Primrose Fairy Frost – Primrose	1 yard	<ul> <li>Cut three 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 55 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> <li>Cut three 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 47 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> <li>See instructions to cut five butterflies.</li> <li>Cut six 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips for the binding.</li> </ul>
(F)	DC6798-Bloom Fairy Dream Flowers – Bloom	1 ¼ yards	<ul> <li>Cut three 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 57 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> <li>Cut three 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 55 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> <li>See instructions to cut ten flowers.</li> <li>See instructions to cut three dots.</li> </ul>
(G)	CM0376-Snow Fairy Frost – Snow	1⁄2 yard	<ul> <li>Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 52 ½" strips.</li> <li>Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 45 ½" strips.</li> </ul>
Back	ing DM6799-Pink Fairy Dreamland – Pink	3 ½ yards	• Cut two 63" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 63" x 73" pieced backing.

#### You will also need:

• 63" x 73" batting, fusible web, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.




Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.


While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

#### **Block Assembly**


- 1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the three butterflies and three dots onto the  $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 28  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip.
- 4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the center strip (Fig. 1).
- 5. Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x  $28\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric C strip to each side of the center strip. Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x  $22\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the center strip to make the center block (Fig. 2).
- 6. Sew one 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to each side of the center block. Sew one 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block (Fig. 3).







- 7. Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 48  $\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric C strip to each side of the center block. Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block (Fig. 4).
- 8. Repeat Steps 1-4 and place the remaining butterflies, dots and flowers onto the center block (Fig. 5) to make the quilt top.





# Quilt Top Assembly

## (Follow Quilt Photo while assembling the quilt top.)

- 9. Sew one 2" x 52  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 45  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 10. Sew one  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  x 55  $\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  x 47  $\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quit top.
- 11. Sew one 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 57  $\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 55  $\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 12. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 13. Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 14. Bind as desired.
