# "Vignette - Aqua"

Size: Approximately 51" x 63" Skill Level: Intermediate

# **Materials**

### **Cutting instructions**

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	CJ6659-Spring Spring Buds – Spring	¼ yard	Cut one 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 7" squares.
(B)	CJ4816-Lagoon Painter's Canvas – Lagoon	1 ¼ yards	<ul> <li>Cut one 9" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 1 ½" x 9" strips and twelve 1 ½" x 7" strips.</li> <li>Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 48 ½" strips.</li> <li>Cut two 2" x 39 ½" WOF strips.</li> <li>Cut two 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 3 ½" squares.</li> <li>Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.</li> </ul>
(C)	CJ6611-Aqua Spring All Over – Aqua	⅓ yard	<ul> <li>Cut three 3 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 3 1/8" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make forty-eight triangles.</li> <li>Cut two 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.</li> </ul>
(D)	CJ4816-Bottle Painter's Canvas – Bottle	⅓ yard	<ul> <li>Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips.</li> <li>Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twenty-four 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips.</li> <li>Cut one 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips and twelve 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.</li> </ul>
(E)	CJ6557-Apricot Cherry Blossom – Apricot	½ yard	<ul> <li>Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 ½" squares.</li> <li>Cut one 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 ½" squares.</li> </ul>
(F)	CJ6658-Aqua Gathered Poppies – Aqua	¼ yard	• Cut one 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 6 ½" squares.
(G)	CJ6663-Aqua Reflecting Pool – Aqua	1 ¼ yards	<ul> <li>Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 ½" squares.</li> <li>Cut three 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 6 ½" x 51 ½" strips.</li> <li>Cut two 6 ½" x 39 ½" WOF strips.</li> </ul>
Back	ing CJ6662-Bloom Posie Bouquet – Bloom	3 ½ yards	<ul> <li>Cut two 59" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 59" x 71" pieced backing.</li> </ul>

#### You will also need:

• 59" x 71" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.



Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.


While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

# **Block Assembly**


- Sew one 1 ½" x 7" Fabric B strip to each side of one 7" Fabric A square. Sew one 1 ½" x 9" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make one A-block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make six A-blocks total.
- 2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of one 2 ½" Fabric E square. Sew one 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip to the right side of the Fabric E square to make one DED unit (Fig 2). Repeat to make twenty-four DED units total.
- 3. Sew one Fabric C triangle to the Fabric D sides of one DED unit to make one corner block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make twenty-four corner blocks total.




4. Sew one corner block to each side of one A-block to make one Block One (Fig. 4). Repeat to make six Block Ones total.



- 5. Sew one 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric D strip to each end of one 2 ½' x 6 ½" Fabric C strip. Sew one 2 ½" Fabric G square to each end of this strip to make one GG strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make twelve GG strips total.
- 6. Sew one 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of one 6 ½" Fabric F square. Sew one 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the block to make one CC block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make six CC blocks total.
- 7. Sew one 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of one CC block. Sew one GG strip to the top and to the bottom of the block to make one Block Two (Fig. 7). Repeat to make six Block Twos total.



- 8. Place one 3 ½" Fabric B square on the top left corner of one 6 ½" Fabric E square, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
- 9. Follow Figure 10 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 ½" Fabric E square to make one Corner Block (Fig. 11).




10. Repeat Steps 8-9 to make four Corner Blocks total.

# **Quilt Top Assembly**

## (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 11. Sew one Block One to each side of one Block Two to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
- 12. Sew one Block Two to each side of one Block One to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- 13. Sew the four rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
- 14. Sew one 2" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 39 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 15. Sew one 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one Corner Block to each end of one 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 39  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the six
  2 ½" x WOF Fabric B
  strips together, endto-end with 45-degree
  seams, to make the
  binding. Fold this long
  strip in half lengthwise
  with wrong sides
  together and press.
- 18. Bind as desired.
