



Materials

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A) SC5333 Clementine Cotton Couture	1/2 yard	4 Strips – 2" x W.O.F. 15 squares – 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" Cut each square 1x on diagonal
(B) SC5333 Stone Cotton Couture	1/2 yard	4 Strips – 2" x W.O.F. 8 squares – 4 ½" x 4 ½" Cut each square 1x on diagonal
(C) SC5333 Coin Cotton Couture	2/3 yard	4 Strips – 2" x W.O.F. 4 squares – 7 ¾" x 7 ¾" Cut each square 1x on diagonal 1 square 5 7/8" x 5 7/8" Cut 1x on diagonal
(D) SC5333 Bright White Cotton Couture	2/3 yard	24 squares – 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" Cut each square 1x on diagonal 1 square 5 7/8" x 5 7/8" Cut 1x on diagonal
(E) MC6930 Bright White Glitz Bars	1/4 yard (Add 2 yards for backing)	2 Strips – 2" x W.O.F. Cut each to 38 ¾"
(F) MC6933 Coral Glitzy Diamond	1/8 yard	Cut 3 strips 2" x W.O.F. Cut each strip to 38 3/4"
(G) MC6932 Coin Glitz Garden	2/3 yard	4 squares – 4 ½" x 4 ½" 2 Strips – 4 ½" x W.O.F. Cut each to 38 ¾" 4 squares – 7 ¾" x 7 ¾" Cut each 1x on diagonal 2 squares – 5 7/8" x 5 7/8" Cut 1x on diagonal
(H) MC6931 Pink Glitz Flower	1/4 yard	Cut 1 strip 4 1/4" x W.O.F. Cut into 8 squares 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" Cut each square 1x on diagonal


Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.


Directions:

Always refer to photo of quilt.


1. Make (13) units.



1 - White (D)
 2 - Orange (A)
 3 and 4 - White (D)



2. Sew (2) center rows. Use (3) units from Step 1 per row.




- 3. Sew rows together with a 2" strip of 'E'. Sew an additional strip to the top and bottom.
- 4. Sew next 2 rows.

Make (8) units.



Make (4) units.



Sew one row to the top of center unit. Sew one row to the bottom of center unit.



- 5. Sew a 2" strip of 'F' to the top. Repeat with a strip on the bottom.
- 6. Sew the next two sections.

Cut (13) 2" x 2" squares of 'A'

Cut (12) 2" x 2" squares of 'B'

Sew together – every other color – starting and ending with 'A'.

Sew pieced strip to 2" strip of 'B' - 2" x 38 34"

Cut (13) 2" x 2" squares of 'C'

Cut (12) 2" x 2" squares of 'A'

Sew together - every other color - starting and ending with 'C'.


Sew pieced strip to 2" strip of 'C' - 2" x 38 34"

REPEAT for 2nd section

Sew the section with the strip of 'C' down – to the top of the quilt top. Sew the section of the strip of 'B' up – to the bottom of the quilt top.

7. Sew the last 2 sections.

Use remaining 6 sections made in step 1.



8. Sew (1) strip of 'G' 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{3}{4}$ " to top of the quilt. Sew (1) strip of 'G' 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{3}{4}$ " to the bottom of the quilt.

Quilt top is complete.

Backing is one piece of fabric (E)

44"/45" x 72"

Sew 2 ½" strips of binding fabric (C) end to end and prepare for French Fold Binding.
