Also Needed: $45^{\prime \prime} \times 65^{\prime \prime}$ backing, $45^{\prime \prime} \times 65^{\prime \prime}$ batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, and mat.

* Triangle is $4 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 71 / 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ at the base. To make template fold a $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 71 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle in half. Trim from the top of fold to the outer corners of the bottom edge. $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance is included on all sides.
** To make $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ triangle add $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance to the fold side of the pattern. Make one right half and one left half.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Directions:

## This quilt is made of different $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished blocks combined with some scattered 4 1/2" unfinished blocks. When put together it creates a random, scrappy look. Rows will be assembled vertically.

1. Block 'A' - Sew together one CX6555 Red $41 / 2$ " square, one CX6322 $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square, and (2) CX4490 $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares into a 4-patch checkerboard. Make (5). Set aside remaining pieces.
2. Block 'B' - Make (38) 4-patch blocks using CX4490, CX3071, CX4835 Boy, CX5514, CX6555 Rouge, CX1065 Red, and K4151 $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares randomly. Sew together (4) 4-patch blocks to make (1) 16-patch block $8 \frac{112 " \prime}{\prime \prime}$ square. Make 6 total. Set aside with remaining $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} 4$-patch units - (12) total.
3. Block 'C' - Sew together one each CX4835 Rouge, CX1065 Dalmatian, CX4490, and CX6898 $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips in order to make (1) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block. Make (9) total. Set aside.
4. To assemble Row \#1 - from the top - sew a 'C' block, set horizontally, to the bottom of an 'A' block. Sew one CX6322 $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square to one CX4490 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew to the bottom of 'C'. Add a 'B' block next. Make an $8{ }^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ square using one CX6322. $4^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ square, one CX4490 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} 4$-patch, and one CX6555 Rouge $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew to 'B'. Follow with a 'C' block set horizontally. Make an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
 ' ${ }^{\prime}$ '. Finish with a ' $\mathrm{B}^{\prime}$ block.
5. 

To make Row \#2 - Sew an 'A' block to the bottom of a 'B' block. Sew together (2) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} 4$-patch blocks. Sew to 'A'. Make an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block using one CX6322 $4^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ square, (2) CX4490 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, and one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ 4 -patch. Sew to the bottom of the strip. Add a ' $C^{\prime}$ block set vertically. Next add a ' $B$ ' block. Make an 8 $1 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ block using one CX6322 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, (1) CX4490 $4^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ square, (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} 4$-patch, and one CX6555 Red. Sew to the bottom of the strip. Finish with a 'C' block set vertically. Sew to the right side of Row \#1.
6. Row \#3 - Sew one ' $B^{\prime}$ block the bottom of one ' $C$ ' block set vertically. Sew one ' $C$ ' block set horizontally to the bottom of ' $B^{\prime}$ '. Add an ' $A^{\prime}$ ' block. Sew together (2) $41 / 2$ " 4 -patch blocks. Sew to the bottom of the strip. Add an $8{ }^{1 / 2 \prime}$ square using (1) CX6355 $4 \frac{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}{}$ square, (1) $4^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} 4$-patch, (1), CX4490 $4^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ square, and (1) CX6555 Red $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Finish row with this block. Sew Row \#3 to the right side of Row \#2.
 square, and (1) CX6555 Red $41^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Add a ' $C^{\prime}$ block set vertically. Make an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square using (1) CX6322 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, (1) CX4490 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} 4$-patch, and (1) CX6555 Red $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew to the bottom of the strip. Add a 'C' block set vertically. Sew one CX6322 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square and (1) CX4490 $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square together. Sew to the bottom of the strip. Add a 'B' block and an 'A' block. Make the final $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square using (1) CX6322 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (3) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} 4$-patch blocks. Sew to the bottom of the strip. Sew Row \#4 to the right side of Row \#3.
8. For the outer rows alternate CX6555 White and CX4835 Boy triangles on the outside edge with (6) CX4490, (2) CX3071, and (2) K4151 triangles on the inside edge. Finish each end with a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ triangle piece as shown Make two. Sew one to each side of the quilt as shown.
9. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
10. Quilt as desired.
11. Bind quilt using CX6898 $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips pieced as needed for length.
