12.5" repeat



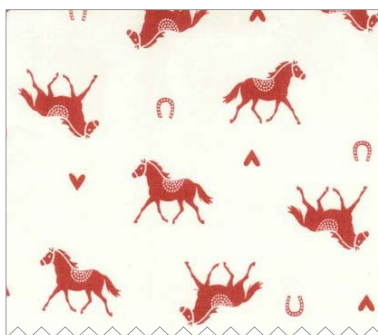

CX7233 Denim Outstanding in their Field	1 3/4 yards	(2) 10 1/2" x 37" * (2) 10 1/2" x 25" *
CX7236 Denim Lucky Horseshoe	5/8 yard	(2) 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" (2) 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" (5) 2 1/2" x W.O.F. – binding
CX7239 Red Pony Up	1/2 yard	(21) 4 1/2" squares
CX4594 Red Bud Loop	1/4 yard	(4) 2" x W.O.F.
CX7238 Red Hot to Trot	1/4 yard	(4) 2" x W.O.F.
CX4594 Denim Bud Loop	1/4 yard	(42) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"
CX7238 Denim Hot to Trot	1/4 yard	(21) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
CX7235 Crème Cash	Fat 1/8	(8) 3" squares
CX7236 Red Lucky Horseshoe	Fat 1/8	(8) 3" squares

Also Needed: 45" x 60" backing, 45" x 60" batting, thread to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, and mat.

* Center on border motifs as shown. Cut (1) 37" & (1) 25" piece each side

Directions:

1. To make one pinwheel block, place one CX7235 3" square right sides together on top of one CX7236 Red 3" square. Draw a diagonal line from

corner to corner. Sew a seam $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut apart on the line. Press open. Yield = (2) right square triangles. Make (16) total. Trim each to an accurate $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares as shown in a pinwheel pattern. Make (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pinwheel squares. Sew together in a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strip as shown.

2. Fold the CX7233 $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 37" piece in half. Mark the center. Align the center mark with the center of the pinwheel strip (between blocks #2 and #3). Pin in place to within $\frac{1}{4}$ " of each end of the pinwheel strip. Sew in place between the pins. Repeat using CX7233 $10\frac{1}{2}$ " 25" piece. Pin the center of the end of the pinwheel strip. Sew in place to within $\frac{1}{4}$ " of each end. Miter the corner of the two CX7233 strips. Repeat for the remaining two sides.

3. Sew together (1) CX4594 Red 2" x W.O.F. strip with (1) CX7238 Red 2" x W.O.F. strip. Make (4) pairs. Cut across strip every $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to make $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Make (44) total. Sew together (12) blocks alternating the direction of the stripes as shown. Make (2). Sew one strip to each side of the quilt. Make (2) strips using (10) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks. Sew one strip to the top and one strip to the bottom.

4. Sew one CX7236 Denim $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to each side of the quilt. Sew one CX7236 Denim $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the top and bottom.

5. Sew one CX4594 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to each side of one CX7238 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " piece. Make (21) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

6. Sew together (4) CX7239 $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares alternating with (4) pieced squares from step #5. Make (2). Sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt. Sew together the remaining red and blue $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into two (13) block strips maintaining the alternating pattern as shown. Sew one strip to each side.

7. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.

8. Quilt as desired.

9. Bind quilt using CX7236 Denim $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips pieced as needed for length.
