



Baby Swaddle Blanket

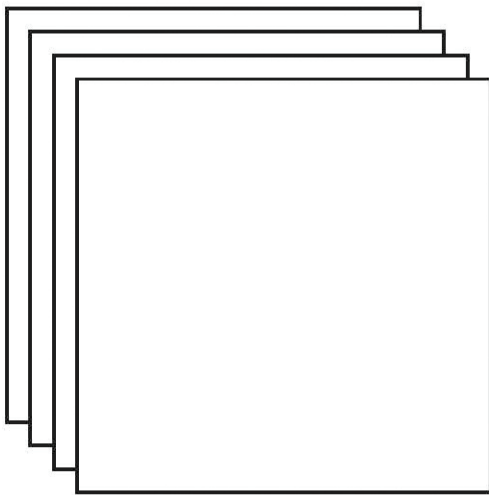
Baby Swaddle Blanket

Cutting Instructions:

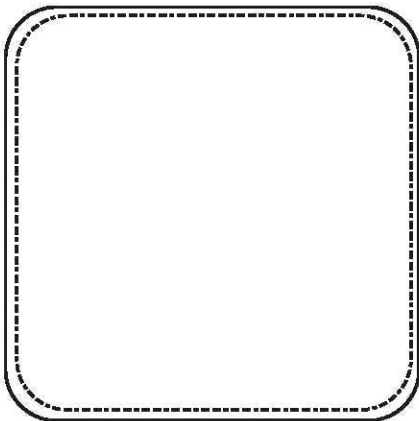
Main Fabric: 40" square (2-4 layers depending on preference)
Binding Fabric: 15" square

Blanket:

Layer 2-4 40" squares on top of each other, and stitch together around all four sides using a 1/4" seam.

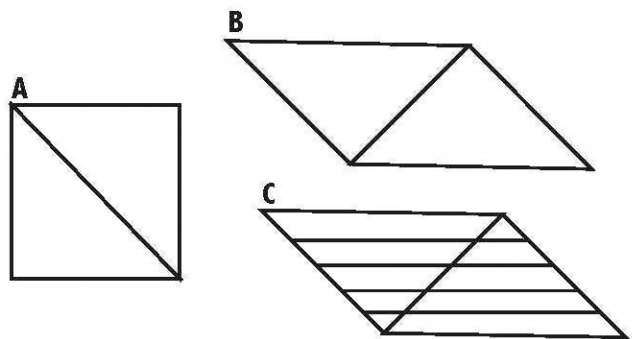


Round each corner using a 2 1/2" circle template.



Binding:

Cut 15" square in half on the diagonal. (A)
Sew together two short sides. (B)
Then cut 2 1/2" strips (C) and seam them together to make a continuous binding strip.



Pin (don't press) binding in half every 6-8" to keep bias from twisting.

Aligning all raw edges pin/clip binding on to the edge of the 40" square. Sew around the blanket with a 1/4" seam.

Roll binding over and stitch down with a 1/8" topstitch.

TIP: I found it easier to use wonderclips to keep the binding in place as I topstitched. I also used a stiletto to keep the binding pulled over around the edge of the blanket.
