




Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

(A)	CX7248-Graphite Bot Boy – Graphite	1 ¼ yards	Cut sixteen Template 1 triangles.Cut sixteen Template 2 triangles.Cut sixteen Template 3 triangles.
(B)	CX7253-Lime Atomic Stars – Lime	¾ yard	Cut eight Template 1 triangles.Cut eight Template 2 triangles.Cut eight Template 3 triangles.
(C)	CX7252-Retro Bot Dot – Retro	¾ yard	Cut eight Template 1 triangles.Cut eight Template 2 triangles.Cut eight Template 3 triangles.
(D)	CX7253-Black Atomic Stars – Black	¾ yard	Cut eight Template 1 triangles.Cut eight Template 2 triangles.Cut eight Template 3 triangles.
(E)	CX7249-Teal Bot Dog – Teal	¾ yard	Cut eight Template 1 triangles.Cut eight Template 2 triangles.Cut eight Template 3 triangles.
(F)	CX6574-Black Little Stripe – Black	½ yard	• Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
(G)	SC5333-White Cotton Couture – White	¾ yard	Cut eight Template 1 triangles.Cut eight Template 2 triangles.Cut eight Template 3 triangles.
Back	ing CX7248-Graphite Bot Boy – Graphite	3 ¾ yards	Cut two 64" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 72" pieced backing.

You will also need:

• 64" x 72" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, template plastic, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.



Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.




Block Assembly


- 1. Place one Fabric G-Template 1 triangle on top of one Fabric A-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 1). Sew the two triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.
- 2. Place one Fabric G-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric A-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 2). Sew the two triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make one Block One (Fig. 3). Trim to measure 8 ½" square.
- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make eight Block Ones total.




- 4. Repeat Steps 1-2 using eight Fabric A-Template 1 triangles, eight Fabric B-Template 2 triangles and eight Fabric A-Template 3 triangles to make eight 8 ½" Block Twos (Fig. 4).
- 5. Repeat Steps 1-2 using eight Fabric B-Template 1 triangles, eight Fabric C-Template 2 triangles and eight Fabric B-Template 3 triangles to make eight 8 ½" Block Threes (Fig. 5).
- 6. Repeat Steps 1-2 using eight Fabric C-Template 1 triangles, eight Fabric D-Template 2 triangles and eight Fabric C-Template 3 triangles to make eight 8 ½" Block Fours (Fig. 6).








- 7. Repeat Steps 1-2 using eight Fabric D-Template 1 triangles, eight Fabric E-Template 2 triangles and eight Fabric D-Template 3 triangles to make eight 8 ½" Block Fives (Fig. 7).
- 8. Repeat Steps 1-2 using eight Fabric E-Template 1 triangles, eight Fabric A-Template 2 triangles and eight Fabric E-Template 3 triangles to make eight 8 ½" Block Sixes (Fig. 8).
- 9. Repeat Steps 1-2 using eight Fabric A-Template 1 triangles, eight Fabric G-Template 2 triangles and eight Fabric A-Template 3 triangles to make eight 8 ½" Block Sevens (Fig. 9).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 10. Sew the eight Block Ones together to make Column One. Repeat to make the six assorted columns using the remaining blocks.
- 11. Sew the eight columns together to make the quilt top.
- 12. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 13. Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
- 14. Bind as desired.
