| (A) | $\begin{gathered} \text { CX6574-Red } \\ \text { Little Stripe - Red } \end{gathered}$ | 2/3 yard | - Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips. <br> - Cut five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding. |

| (B) | CX7248-Blue Bot Boy - Blue | $1 / 3$ yard | - Cut one $101 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strip. |
| (C) | CX7249-Green Bot Dog - Green | $3 / 8$ yard | - Cut two $51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips. |
| (D) | CX7252-Brite <br> Bot Dot - Brite | 3/8 yard | - Cut two $51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips. |
| (E) | CX7253-Nite Atomic Stars - Nite | $1 / 3$ yard | - Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ten $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| (F) | $\begin{gathered} \text { CX7253-Red } \\ \text { Atomic Stars - Red } \end{gathered}$ | $1 / 3$ yard | - Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ten $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| (G) | $\begin{gathered} \text { SC5333-Green } \\ \text { Cotton Couture - Green } \end{gathered}$ | 1/4 yard | - Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. |
| (H) | $\begin{gathered} \text { SC5333-Lemon } \\ \text { Cotton Couture - Lemon } \end{gathered}$ | 1/4 yard | - Cut two $21 / 1 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. |
| (I) | SC5333-White <br> Cotton Couture - White | 3/8 yard | - Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. |
| (J) | SC5333-Cobalt Cotton Couture - Cobalt | 1/4 yard | - Cut four $11 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips. |
| Back | CX7253-Nite <br> Atomic Stars - Nite | $23 / 4$ yards | - Cut two 48 " x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 48 " $\times 62^{\prime \prime}$ pieced backing. |

## You will also need:

- 48 " x 62 " batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Block Assembly

1. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric I strip and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric G strip together lengthwise to make one IG strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second IG strip set.
2. Cut the IG strip sets into twenty $21 / 2 \prime \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ IG strips (Fig. 2).
3. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric H strip and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric I strip together lengthwise to make one HI strip set (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second HI strip set.
4. Cut the HI strip sets into twenty $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \mathrm{HI}$ strips (Fig. 4).
5. Sew one IG strip to the top of one HI strip to make one GH block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make twenty GH blocks total.


## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
6. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip lengthwise to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Seven.
7. Sew five $41 / 2$ " Fabric F squares and five GH blocks together, alternating them, to make Row Two.
8. Sew five GH blocks and five $41 / 2$ " Fabric E squares together, alternating them, to make Row Three.
9. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip lengthwise. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of one $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to make Row Four.
10. Sew five $41 / 2$ " Fabric E squares and five GH blocks together, alternating them, to make Row Five.
11. Sew five GH blocks and five $41 / 2$ " Fabric F squares together, alternating them, to make Row Six.
12. Sew the seven rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the five $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric A strips together, end-to-end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
15. Bind as desired.
