| (A) | CX7317-Black <br> Flamingos in Paradise - Black | $21 / 4$ yards | - Cut (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 76$ " length of fabric (LOF) strips. <br> - Cut (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 681 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips. <br> - Cut (12) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from the remaining fabric. |

| (B) | $\qquad$ | $1 / 2$ yard | - Cut three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| (C) | CX7320-Flamingo <br> Flamingo Floral - Flamingo | $1 / 2$ yard | - Cut six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| (D) | CX7319-Flamingo Flamingo Flock - Flamingo | 7/8 yard | - Cut three $21 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $21 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ strips. <br> - Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. <br> - Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. |
| (E) | $\begin{aligned} & \text { CX5514-Black } \\ & \text { Dots - Black } \end{aligned}$ | $1 / 2$ yard | - Cut six $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. |
| (F) | CX7318-Flamingo <br> Flock to the Oasis - Flamingo | $1 / 2$ yard | - Cut three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| (G) | CX7164-Black <br> Starboard Stripe - Black | 2/3 yard | - Cut eight $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding. |
| (H) | $\begin{aligned} & \text { SC5333-Spa } \\ & \text { Cotton Couture - Spa } \end{aligned}$ | 1 yard | - Cut twelve $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (192) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| (I) | SC5333-Blossom Cotton Couture - Blossom | 7/8 yard | - Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. <br> - Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$ strips. <br> - Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58^{1 / 2 "}$ strips. |
| (J) | SC5333-Ozone Cotton Couture - Ozone | 1 yard | - Cut sixteen $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ strips. |
| (K) | $\begin{gathered} \text { SC5333-Luna } \\ \text { Cotton Couture - Luna } \end{gathered}$ | $11 / 8$ yards | - Cut twelve $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (192) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares. <br> - Cut two 2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty 2" squares. |
| Bac | $\begin{array}{c\|c} \hline \text { ing } & \text { CX7320-Flamingo } \\ \text { Flamingo Floral - Flamingo } \end{array}$ | $51 / 4$ yards | - Cut two 94 " x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the $76^{\prime \prime} \times 94$ " pieced backing. |

## You will also need:

- 76 " $\times 94$ " batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Block Assembly

1. Place one $21 / 2$ " Fabric H square on the top left corner of one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.
2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ ' Fabric $H$ square to the upper right corner and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $K$ squares to the lower left and right corners of the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square to make one Unit 1 (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make six Unit 1's total.

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and use Figures 5-11 for fabric identification, direction and location to make the designated number of units.

5. Place one $21 / 2$ " Fabric $K$ square on the left side of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric $C$ strip, right sides together (Fig. 12). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 13). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

6. Place one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H square on the right side of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 14). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 15). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make one Unit 9.
7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make twenty-four Unit 9's total.
8. Repeat Steps $5-6$ using twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H squares, twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ " Fabric C strips and twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K squares to make twenty-four Unit 10's (Fig. 16).

9. Repeat Steps 5-6 and use Figures 17-20 for fabric identification, direction and location to make the designated number of units.

10. Repeat Steps 5-6 and use Figures 21-24 for fabric identification, direction and location to make the designated number of units.

11. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric E strip and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric D strip together lengthwise to make one ED strip set (Fig. 25). Repeat to make three ED strip sets total.
12. Cut the three ED strip sets into forty-eight $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ ED units (Fig. 26).
13. Sew two ED units together to make one Unit 19 (Fig. 27). Repeat to make twenty-four Unit 19's total.

14. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric E strip and one $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strip together lengthwise to make one El strip set (Fig. 28). Repeat to make three El strip sets total.
15. Cut the three El strip sets into forty-eight $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " El units (Fig. 29).
16. Sew two El units together to make one Unit 20
(Fig. 30). Repeat to make twenty-four Unit 20's total.

## Refer to Figure 31 for Steps 17-19.

17. Sew (1) Unit 9 to the top of one Unit 3. Sew one Unit 10 to the bottom of the Unit 3. Sew this strip to the left side of one $81 / 2$ " Fabric A square. Sew one Unit 10 to the top of one Unit 4. Sew one Unit 9 to the bottom of the Unit 4. Sew this strip to the right side of the Fabric A square.
18. Sew (1) Unit 19, one Unit 10, one Unit 1, one Unit 9 and one Unit 19 together in that order. Sew this strip to the top of the Fabric A square from Step 16. Sew one Unit 19, one Unit 9, one Unit 2, one Unit 10 and one Unit 19 together. Sew this strip to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make one Block One.
19. Repeat Steps $16-17$ to make six Block Ones total.

22. Sew four 2" Fabric K squares and three 2" $\times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strips together, alternating them, to make one sashing row. Repeat to make five sashing rows total.

## Quilt Top Assembly

## (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

23. Sew (1) 2" x $161 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip, one Block One, (1) 2 " $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip, one Block Two, (1) 2 " $\times 16 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " Fabric J strip, one Block One and (1) 2 " $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip together to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
24. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip, one Block Two, (1) $2 " \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strip, one Block One, (1) 2 " $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip, one Block Two and (1) 2 " $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
25. Sew the five sashing rows and four pieced rows, in numerical order, together, alternating them, to make the Center Block.
26. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 581 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
27. Sew one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 76$ " Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 681 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
28. Layer and quilt as desired.
29. Sew the eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
30. Bind as desired.
