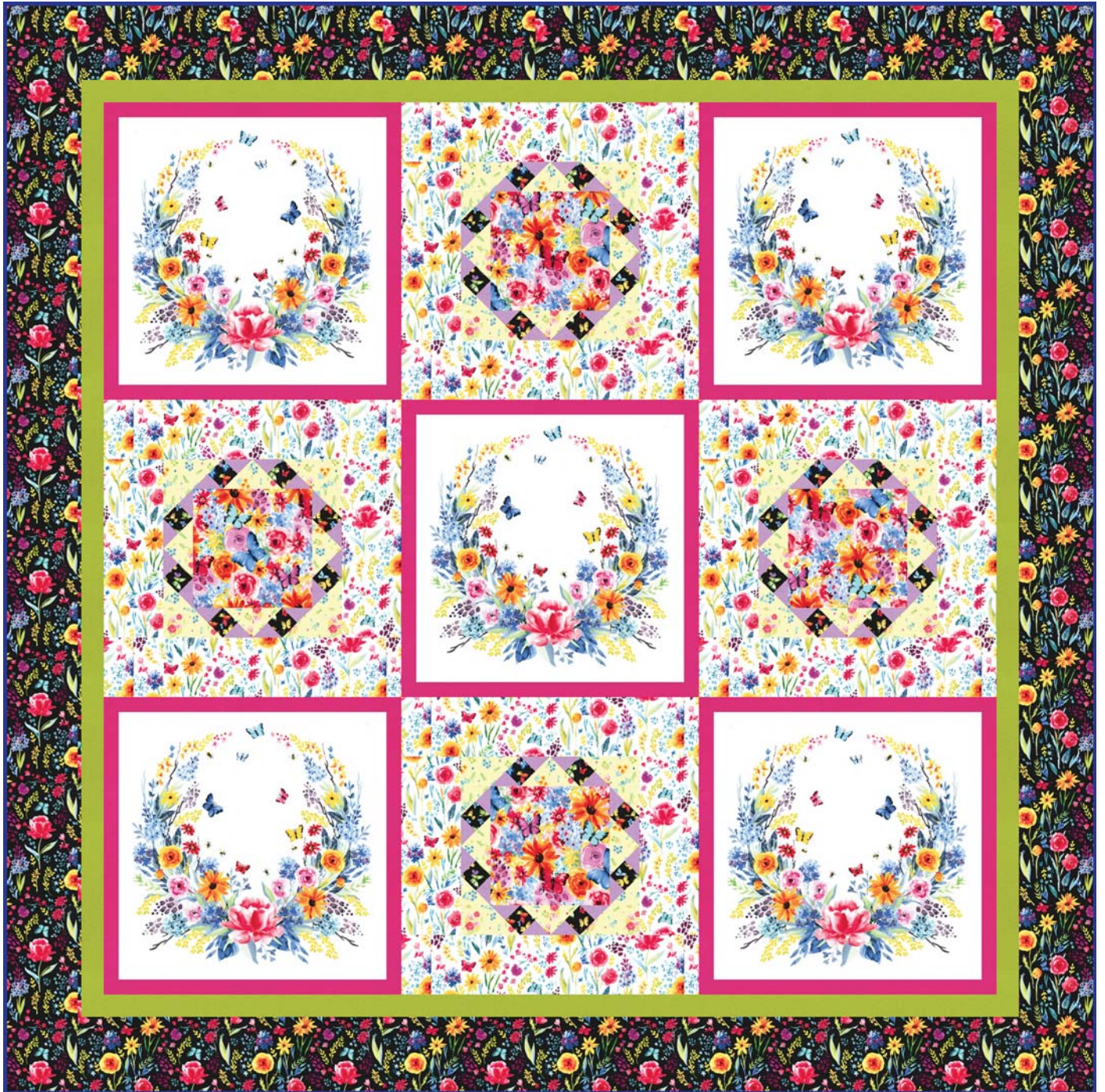

(H) SC5333-Kryptonite	1 bolt (7 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards)	1 bolt (15 yards)
(I) DC7357-Black	2 bolts (22 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards)	3 bolts (45 yards)
(J) SC5333-Cobalt	1 bolt (8 yards)	2 bolts (16 yards)
(Back) DC7356-Multi	4 bolts (54 yards)	8 bolts (108 yards)

Size: Approximately 73" x 73" Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

Materials

Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	DC7355-White Floral Wreath Panel – White	3 panels	• Fussy cut five 18 ½" squares, each centered on a wreath.
(B)	DC7357-White Meadow Menagerie – White	1 yard	• Cut one 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 4 ½" x 12 ½" strips. • Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 4 ½" x 20 ½" strips.
(C)	DC7358-Yellow Dainty Blooms – Yellow	¾ yard	• Cut three 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two 2 ⅞" squares. Cut squares across one diagonal to make sixty-four triangles. • Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2 ½" squares.
(D)	DC7359-Black Butterfly Free – Black	¼ yard	• Cut two 3 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 3 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make sixty-four triangles.
(E)	SC5333-Wisteria Cotton Couture – Wisteria	¼ yard	• Cut two 3 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 3 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make sixty-four triangles.
(F)	DC7356-Multi Big Bang Blooms – Multi	¾ yard	• Cut one 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 8 ½" squares.
(G)	SC5333-Raspberry Cotton Couture – Raspberry	⅝ yard	• Cut five 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strips into ten 1 ½" x 18 ½" strips. • Cut five 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strips into ten 1 ½" x 20 ½" strips.
(H)	SC5333-Kryptonite Cotton Couture – Kryptonite	⅝ yard	• Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 63 ½" strips. • Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 60 ½" strips.
(I)	DC7357-Black Meadow Menagerie – Black	1 ⅞ yards	• Cut two 5 ½" x 63 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. • Cut two 5 ½" x 73 ½" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.
(J)	SC5333-Cobalt Cotton Couture – Cobalt	⅔ yard	• Cut eight 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
Backing	DC7356-Multi Big Bang Blooms – Multi	4 ½ yards	• Cut two 81" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 81" x 81" pieced backing.

You will also need:

- 81" x 81" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Block Assembly

1. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of one $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make one Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make five Block Ones total.

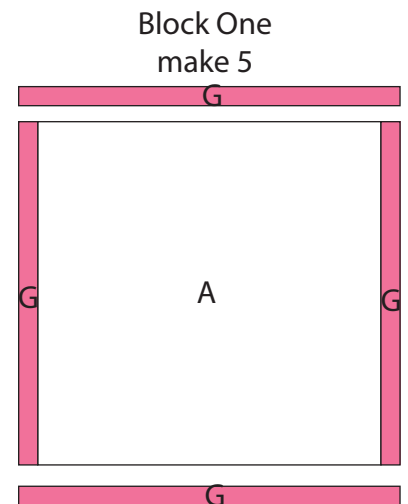

2. Sew one Fabric C triangle, one Fabric D triangle and one Fabric E triangle together to make one Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make thirty-two Unit 1 squares total.
3. Sew one Fabric D triangle, one Fabric C triangle and one Fabric E triangle together to make one Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make thirty-two Unit 2 squares total.
4. Sew two Unit 1 squares and two Unit 2 squares together, in that order, to make one Unit 3 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make sixteen Unit 3 strips total. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.
5. Sew one unit 3 strip to each side of one $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square. Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to each end of one Unit 3 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make one Unit 4 block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make four Unit 4 blocks total.

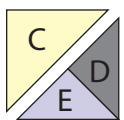

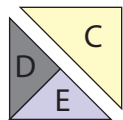

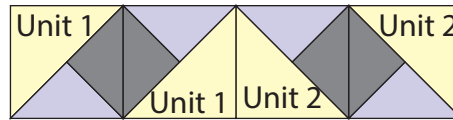

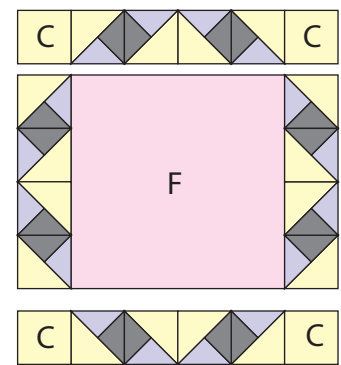

6. Sew one 4 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of one Unit 4 block. Sew one 4 ½" x 20 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 4 block to make one Block Two (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block Twos total.

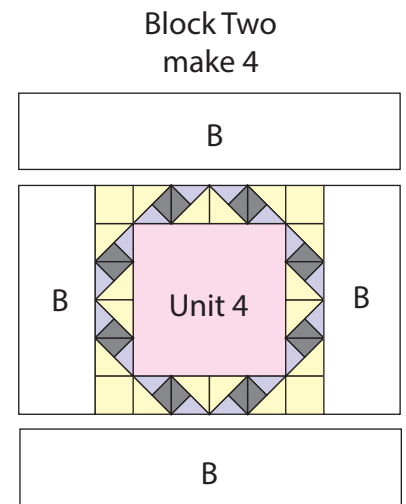
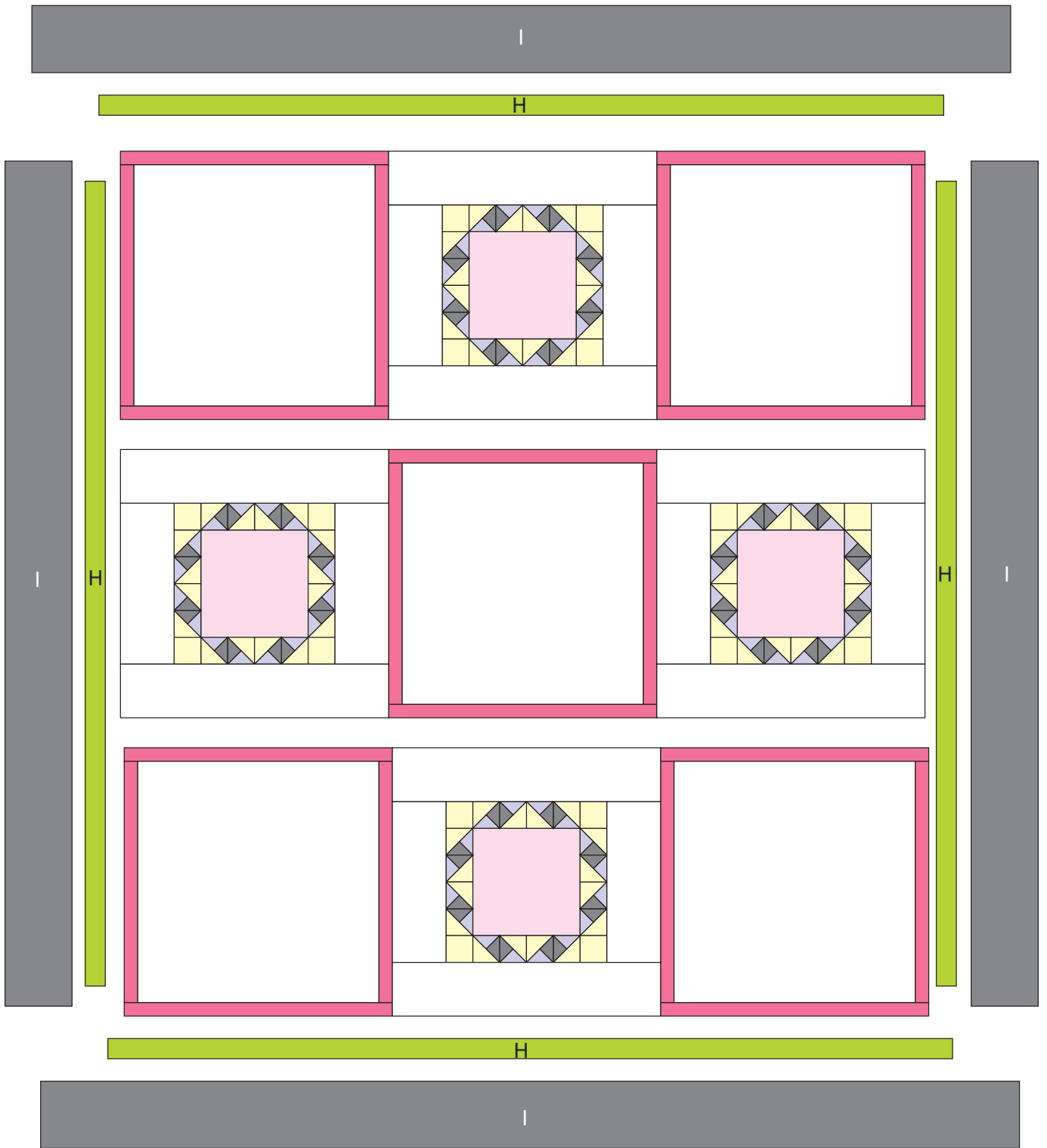

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

7. Sew one Block One to each side of one Block Two to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
8. Sew one Block Two to each side of one Block One to make Row Two.
9. Sew the three rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
10. Sew one 2" x 60 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2" x 63 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew one 5 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 5 ½" x 73 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the eight 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
