Size: Approximately 39" x 50" Skill Level: Intermediate

Materials

Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	SC5333-Midnite Cotton Couture – Midnite	1 ½ yards	• Cut one 50 ½" x 39 ½" length of fabric strip.
(B)	CX7503-Rainbow Ring of Flowers – Rainbow	⅓ yard	Fussy cut one 9" circle, centered on one medallion circle.
(C)	CX7504-Bloom Forever Love – Bloom	½ yard	See instructions to cut six # 2 petals.
(D)	CX7502-Sunshine Flowertopia – Sunshine	1 yard	See instructions to cut seven # 1 petals.
(E)	CX7505-Flower Paisley Blossom – Flower	1 ¼ yards	 See instructions to cut three # 3 petals. See instructions to cut nine # 4 petals. See instructions to cut five # 5 petals. See instructions to cut one #6 petal.
(F)	CX7505-Garden Paisley Blossom – Garden	¼ yard	See instructions to cut six # 4 petals.
(G)	CX7504-Leaf Forever Love – Leaf	½ yard	 See instructions to cut three # 3 petals. See instructions to cut six # 4 petals.
(H)	CX7506-Sunshine Forever – Sunshine	½ yard	• Cut five 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
Back	ing CX7502-Rainbow Flowertopia – Rainbow	2 ¾ yards	Cut two 47" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 47" x 58" pieced backing.

You will also need:

^{• 47&}quot; x 58" batting, fusible web, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.


While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press forty-six assorted petals and 9" Fabric B circle onto the 39 ½ x 50 ½" Fabric A strip. Once the petals are positioned onto the background, trim the petals even with background.
- 4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the quilt top.
- 5. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 6. Sew the five 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
- 7. Bind as desired.

Once you position and press the petals to the background. Trim the petals even with the background
