

"Holiday Row"

Size: Approximately 38" x 44" Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

Materials

Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	CX7387-Multi Holiday Row – Multi	1 ¼ yards	 Fussy cut two 3 ½" x 32 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on the pink stripe. Fussy cut two 3 ½" x 38 ½" LOF strips, each centered on the pink stripe.
(B)	SC5333-Dirt Cotton Couture – Dirt	⅓ yard	See instructions to cut one tree trunk.
(C)	SC5333-Cherry Cotton Couture – Cherry	⅔ yard	 Cut two 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips. Cut two 1 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips. Cut five 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding. See instructions to cut six 2" circles.
(D)	SC5333-Bright White Cotton Couture – Bright White	1 yard	• Cut one 30 ½" x 36 ½" strip.
(E)	CX7398-Aqua Holiday Ho! – Aqua	⅓ yard	 Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 3 ½" squares. See instructions to cut six 3" circles.
(F)	CX7398-Red Holiday Ho! – Red	⅓ yard	See instructions to cut seven 3" circles.
(G)	CX7388-Multi Tinsel Tiles – Multi	⅓ yard	See instructions to cut five 3" circles.
(H)	CX7399-Aqua Oh Ho No – Aqua	⅓ yard	See instructions to cut four 3" circles.
(1)	SC5333-Lime Cotton Couture – Lime	⅓ yard	 See instructions to cut two Scroll 1 components. See instructions to cut one Scroll 2 component. See instructions to cut nine 2" circles.
(J)	SC5333-Spearmint Cotton Couture – Spearmint	½ yard	 See instructions to cut one Scroll 1 component. See instructions to cut one Scroll 2 component. See instructions to cut seven 2" circles.
(K)	SC5333-Green Cotton Couture – Green	⅓ yard	 See instructions to cut one Scroll 1 component. See instructions to cut two Scroll 2 components. See instructions to cut five 2" circles.
(L)	SC5333-Pink Cotton Couture – Pink	⅓ yard	See instructions to cut five 2" circles.
Back	ing CX7399-Aqua Oh Ho No – Aqua	2 ¾ yards	Cut two 46" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 46" x 52" pieced backing.

You will also need:

• 46" x 52" batting, fusible web, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Block Assembly

- 1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Refer to the Figure 1 to arrange and press the twenty-two 3" circles, thirty-two 2" circles, four Scroll 1 components, four Scroll 2 components and one tree trunk onto the 30 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric D strip.






4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the Center Block.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 5. Sew one 1 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 1 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 6. Sew one 3 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 3 ½" Fabric E square to each end of one 3 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric A strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 7. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 8. Sew the five 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
- 9. Bind as desired.
