DC7355 White Floral Wreath Panel	(2) Panels *	(4) 17 ½" W x 21 ½" H ** (16) 3 ½" squares (from trimmed scraps)
DC7357 White Meadow Menagerie	1/4 yard	(2) 3 ½" x 41 ½"
DC7358 White Dainty Blooms	7/8 yard	(16) 3 ½" square (16) 3 ½" x 6 ½" (10) 4 ¾" x 8 7/8"
DC7359 White Butterfly Free	1/4 yard	(4) 6 ½" square (10) half circles *** (1) 2 ¾" circle ***
CX7161 Cobalt Gingham Play	5/8 yard	(4) 3 ½" square (12) fan blades *** (4) 1 ½" x 41 ½" (5) 2 ½" x W.O.F. - binding
CX7161 Luna Gingham Play	1/8 yard	(4) 3 ½" square (12) fan blades ***
CX7161 Leaf Gingham Play	1/8 yard	(4) 3 ½" square (12) fan blades ***
CX7161 Marigold Gingham Play	1/8 yard	(4) 3 ½" square (12) fan blades ***
CX7161 Cherry Gingham Play	1/8 yard	(4) 3 ½" square (12) fan blades ***
CX7161 Lavender Gingham Play	1/8 yard	(4) 3 ½" square (12) fan blades ***
CX7161 Pink Gingham Play	1/8 yard	(4) 3 ½" square (12) fan blades ***
CX7161 Pumpkin Gingham Play	1/8 yard	(4) 3 ½" square (12) fan blades ***

Also Needed: 45" x 62" backing, 45" x 62" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, and mat.

* Each panel contains (2) wreaths and measures 23 ¾" wide

Directions:

1. To make (one) star block – place one 3 ½” white square right sides together on top of one corner of one DC7359 6 ½” square. Align corners. Sew diagonally across the corner from outside edge to outside edge. Press open. Trim excess fabric from the back. Repeat for each corner. Set aside. Place on CX7161 3 ½” square right sides together on top of one corner as before. Press open. Trim away excess. Repeat for the opposite corner using a different color CX7161 3 ½” square. Use one each CX7161 3 ½” square Cobalt and Lavender for one DC7358 3 ½” x 6 ½”. Repeat using Marigold and Leaf for a second combo. Use Cherry and Pumpkin for the third 3 ½” x 6 ½” piece and Pink and Lavender for the fourth 3 ½” x 6 ½”. Sew one DC7358 3 ½” to each end of each 3 ½” x 6 ½” pieced unit. Make (one piece) 12 ½” x 3 ½”. Sew one pieced 3 ½” x 6 ½” unit to each side of the 6 ½” square. Sew one 12 ½” x 3 ½” pieced unit to the top and bottom of the center square unit. Take care to keep the sequence of the different colored corner in a random configuration as shown. Make (4) 12 ½” blocks total. Set aside.

2. To assemble the middle of the quilt – fold one DC7355 17 ½” W x 21 ½” H panel in half lengthwise. Trim the top edge (the narrow end of the wreath) at a 45° from the top edge of the fold to the outside raw edges. Repeat for each DC7355 panel. With right sides together, place one panel on top of another. Sew along the diagonal side leaving ¼” unstitched at the outside edge. Repeat for the remaining (2) panels. Press seams open. Sew one 12 ½” star block in each corner of the 2-panel units. Pivot the seam at the inner corner. Repeat for the second panel. Place the panels right sides together & sew along the seams leaving ¼” unsewn at each end. Sew remaining 12 ½” star blocks into the (2) remaining corners as shown.

NOTE: There may be excess fabric at the outside edges of the center panel. Trim evenly on all four sides. Set aside.

3. For fan blades – fold one blade in half lengthwise, right sides together. Sew across the flat end. Trim the inside corner at the fold. Turn the point to the right sides and press. Repeat for each fan blade in each color. (96) blades total. Sew

together one blade of each color. (8) in a rainbow sequence as shown to make (1) fan unit. Backstitch the seam at the point end to secure. Make (12) fan units.

4. For the center medallion – sew together two fan units to make a circle. Machine satin stitch the DC7359 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " circle to the center of the medallion as shown. Place completed medallion in the center of the quilt as shown. Stitch in place by hand or machine. (Invisible thread and an open zig-zag stitch was used for this quilt). Carefully remove excess fabric from the back of the quilt. Set aside.

5. For the fan blades – sew one DC7359 half circle piece to the center of the one fan unit. Center fan unit right sides up on one DC7358 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " piece. Stitch in place by hand or machine. Remove excess fabric from the back as in step #4. Make (10) blocks total. Sew (5) blocks together to make (2) rows.

6. Sew one CX7161 Cobalt 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the bottom and top of each fan strip.

7. Sew one DC7357 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to the top of each fan strip as shown.




8. Sew one fan strip unit to the top and bottom of the center quilt panel as shown.

9. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.

10. Quilt as desired.

11. Bind quilt using CX7161 Cobalt 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips pieced as needed for length.
