

Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Notes: Pattern is based on fabric width of 60"; Seam allowance is 1/2".

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	SML7188-Pink Magical Parade – Pink	1 ½ yards	 Fussy cut two 9" x 49" LOF strips, using the border strips. Fussy cut two 7" x 49" LOF strips, using the stars. Cut five 3" x LOF strips centered on stars for the binding.
(B)	SML7188-White Magical Parade – White	1 ½ yards	 Fussy cut one 9" x 49" LOF strip, using a border strip. Fussy cut two 7" x 49" LOF strips, using the stars. See instructions to cut ten stars.
(C)	SML7189-Mint Unicorn Parade – Mint	1 ½ yards	• Fussy cut two 9" x 49" LOF strips, using the border strips.
(D)	SML7191-Blossom Unicorn Forest – Blossom	¼ yard	See instructions to cut five stars.
(E)	SML7192-Blossom Mermaid Magic – Blossom	¼ yard	See instructions to cut five stars.
Back	ing SML7190-White Magic Folk – White	2 yards	Cut one 56" x 72" strip for the back.

You will also need:

^{• 56&}quot; x 72" batting, fusible web, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.



Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.


While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Block Assembly

- 1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/4" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Refer to Figure 1 to arrange and press the three Fabric D stars and two Fabric E stars onto one 7" x 49" Fabric B strip.
- 4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make Star Row One.



5. Repeat Steps 3-4 and use Figure 2 to press five Fabric B stars onto one 7" x 49" Fabric A strip to make one Star Row Two. Repeat to make a second Star Row Two.



Repeat Steps 3-4 and use Figure 3 to press three Fabric E stars and two Fabric D stars onto one 7" x 49" Fabric B strip to make one Star Row Three.






Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 7. Sew the four Star Rows, two 9" x 49" Fabric A strips, two 9" x 49" Fabric C strips and one 9" x 49" Fabric B strip together lengthwise to make the quilt top.
- 8. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 9. Sew the five 3" x LOF Fabric A strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
- 10. Bind as desired.
