Materials

Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Yardage based on 58" wide fabric.

Use $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance except when making the half-square triangles where $\frac{1}{4}$ " is used.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	DC7909-Tropical Hummingbirds & Hibiscus – Tropical	1 ½ yards	 Cut six 7 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy-two 3 ½" x 7 ½" strips for Paper Piecing Template #3. See instructions to cut nine circles for the centers.
(B)	DC7913-Passion Lanai – Passion	⅓ yard	 Cut two 6 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty 3 ¾" x 6 ¼" strips for Paper Piecing Template #8. Cut two 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty 3" x 3 ½" strips for Paper Piecing Template #7.
(C)	DC7913-Orchid Lanai – Orchid	1 ½ yards	 Cut three 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two 3 ½" x 4 ½" strips for Paper Piecing Template #5. Cut three 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 3" x 3 ½" strips for Paper Piecing Template #7. Cut four 6 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 3 ¾" x 6 ¼" strips for Paper Piecing Template #8.
(D)	DC7913-Bamboo Lanai – Bamboo	5 yards	 Cut twenty-four 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy-two 5" x 10 ¾" strips for Cut two 6 ¼" x WOF strips for Paper Piecing Template #1. Cut fifteen 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy-two 3 ½" x 7 ½" strips for Paper Piecing Template #6.
(E)	DC7913-Iris Lanai – Iris	1 ¼ yards	 Cut four 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty 3 ½" x 4 ¼" strips for Paper Piecing Template #4. Cut two 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 3" x 3 ½" strips for Paper Piecing Template #7. Cut two 6 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 3 ¾" x 6 ¼" strips for Paper Piecing Template #8.
(F)	DC7913-Leaf Lanai – Leaf	% yard	• Cut four 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty 3 ½" x 4 ¼" strips for Paper Piecing Template #5.
(G)	DC7911-Jungle Lei Down – Jungle	¾ yard	 Cut ten 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty 2 ¼" x 9" strips for Paper Piecing Template #2.
(H)	DC7913-Jungle Lanai – Jungle	½ yard	• Cut three 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two 3 ½" x 4 ¼" strips for Paper Piecing Template #4.
(1)	DC7911-Iris Lei Down – Iris	¾ yard	• Cut eight 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two 2 ¼" x 9" strips for Paper Piecing Template #2.
(J)	DC7909-Jungle Hummingbirds & Hibiscus – Jungle	⅓ yard	• Cut three 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
(K)	DC7912-Tropical Shadow Palm – Tropical	½ yard	• Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
Back	DC7910-Tropical Birds and Blossoms – Tropical	4 yards	Cut two 68" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 68" x 68" pieced backing.

You will also need:

• 76" x 76" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.



Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Block Assembly

- Using your favorite paper piecing method and the templates provided, sew together the components listed in Figure 1 and Figure 2 to make twenty Unit 1 blocks and twenty Unit 2 blocks.
- 2. Sew one Unit 1 block and one Unit 2 block together along the long side to make one Unit 3 block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make twenty Unit 3 blocks total.
- 3. Sew four Unit 3 blocks together to make one Unit 4 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make five Unit 4 blocks total.



- 4. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 5. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 6. Refer to Figure 5 to arrange and press one Fabric A circle onto the center of one Unit 4 block.
- 7. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make one Unit 5 block.
- 8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make five Unit 5 blocks total.



- 9. Place one 3 ½" Fabric J square on the top left corner of one Unit 5 block, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼"" away from the sewn seam.
- 10. Follow Figure 8 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric J square to each of the remaining corners of the Unit 5 block to make one Block One square (Fig. 9).
- 11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make five Block One squares total.




12. Repeat Steps 1-3, Steps 6-7 and 9-10 and use Figures 10 through 13 for fabric identification, location and seam direction to make four Block Two squares.




Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 13. Sew one Block One square to each side of one Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
- 14. Sew one Block Two square to each side of one Block One square to make Row Two.
- 15. Sew the three rows together to make the quilt top.
- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
- 18. Bind as desired.




Quilt Layout
