#### **Directions:**

1. For one 9 1/2" unfinished block - place (1) K4287 2" square right sides together on one corner of (1) CX7640 3 ½" square. Sew diagonally across the corner. Press open. Trim excess from the back. Repeat for the diagonal corner of CX7640 3 1/2" square. Make (4) and set aside. Place one K4290 2" square right sides together on one corner of (1) K4287 3 ½" square. Sew diagonally across the corner. Press open. Trim excess from the back. Repeat for the other corner on the same side of the square. Make (4).

To assemble the block – sew one CX7640 block to each side of one K4287 block, matching the K4287 corners as shown. Make (2). Sew one K4287 block to each side of one K4290 3 ½" square with K4125 corners next to K4290 square as shown. Sew completed row to the bottom of one CX7640 row, keeping orange points next to the orange square. Repeat for the remaining CX7640 row, as shown to make (1) 9 ½" block with an orange 8-point star in the center. Make (12) blocks total and set aside. Repeat block using CX7640 and K4058 2" squares for the top and bottom rows and K4058 and K1163 with K1165 3 ½" center square for the middle row. Make (12) blocks with a Blue 8-point star in the center.

- 2. To assemble the quilt sew together (1) aqua, (1) chartreuse, (1) aqua, (1) chartreuse, into a row. Make 3 rows. Repeat reversing the sequence (1) chartreuse, (1) aqua, etc....Make (3) rows. Sew rows together alternating pattern to make a checkerboard pattern as shown.
- 3. Sew one K4290 1" x 36 %" piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one K4290 1" x 55 %" (pieced for length) to each side.
- 4. Sew one CX7641 3" x 37  $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one CX7641 3" x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (pieced for length) to each side.
- 5. Trace one of each leaf pattern onto the paper side of the fusible web. Rough cut out. Iron onto the wrong side of K1154. Cut out on pattern lines. Remove paper backing. Arrange leaves as shown or as desired in lower left corner of the quilt. Iron in place. Machine stitch around raw edges to secure.

NOTE: Satin stitch and rayon thread were used.

6. Rough cut out (2) large flowers from remaining CX7640 fabric. Iron flowers onto fusible web. Cut out. Iron in place on quilt top as shown or as desired. Machine stitch edges to finish.

NOTE: Satin stitch and rayon thread were used.

- 7. For the backing remove the selvage edges from CX7641 49  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x W.O.F. pieces. Sew right sides together along 49  $\frac{1}{2}$ " edge to make 49  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 90" piece. Trim to 49  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70" for backing.
- 8. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 9. Quilt as desired.
- 10. Bind quilt using K4125 2 ½" strips, pieced as needed for length.
