**Additional Requirements:** 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  yards backing fabric, 48" x 24" quilt batting, thread to match fabrics, paper to print patterns, template plastic and/or tracing paper, small piece of paper backed fusible webbing, Rotary cutter, ruler and mat, sewing machine, iron and basic sewing supplies

### Directions

Sew all seams right sides together using  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

### Cutting

1. Make templates for pieces A, G, J, K, N and the Border Square. Make templates or tracing paper patterns for the Center Rectangle 7  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and Side Rectangles 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Use these templates and/or patterns to fussy cut the pieces by centering them over the motifs as shown in the photo.
2. Cut the remaining pieces using the measurements given on the fabric chart.
3. Trace two doorknobs onto paper backed fusible webbing. Fuse to black fabric. Cut out doorknobs.

### Making the Haunted Houses (make 2)

1. Sew a piece B to each side of piece A.
2. Sew piece C to the top edge of A-B. Sew piece D to the bottom edge to complete the door.
3. Sew a piece E to each side of the door.
4. Sew piece F to the top of A-E to complete the door unit.
5. Sew pieces G and H together alternating them to make the window strip.
6. Sew a piece I to the top and bottom edge to complete the window unit.
7. Sew the door unit to the window unit to complete the lower house.
8. Sew piece J to piece K to make the roof unit.
9. Sew the roof unit to the lower house.
10. Sew an L piece to each end of piece M.
11. Sew the L-M unit to the roof beginning and ending the stitching  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge of the fabric.
12. Sew the short edge of piece N to the edge of piece L ending the stitching  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the corner. Sew the diagonal edge of piece N to the edge of piece J on the left side and piece K on the right side.

13. Remove paper carefully from doorknobs. Fuse in place on doors. Zigzag stitch around the edges.

### **Making the Center**

1. Following the layout diagram, sew a haunted house to either side of the Center Rectangle.
2. Sew the Side Rectangles to the remaining edge of the houses.

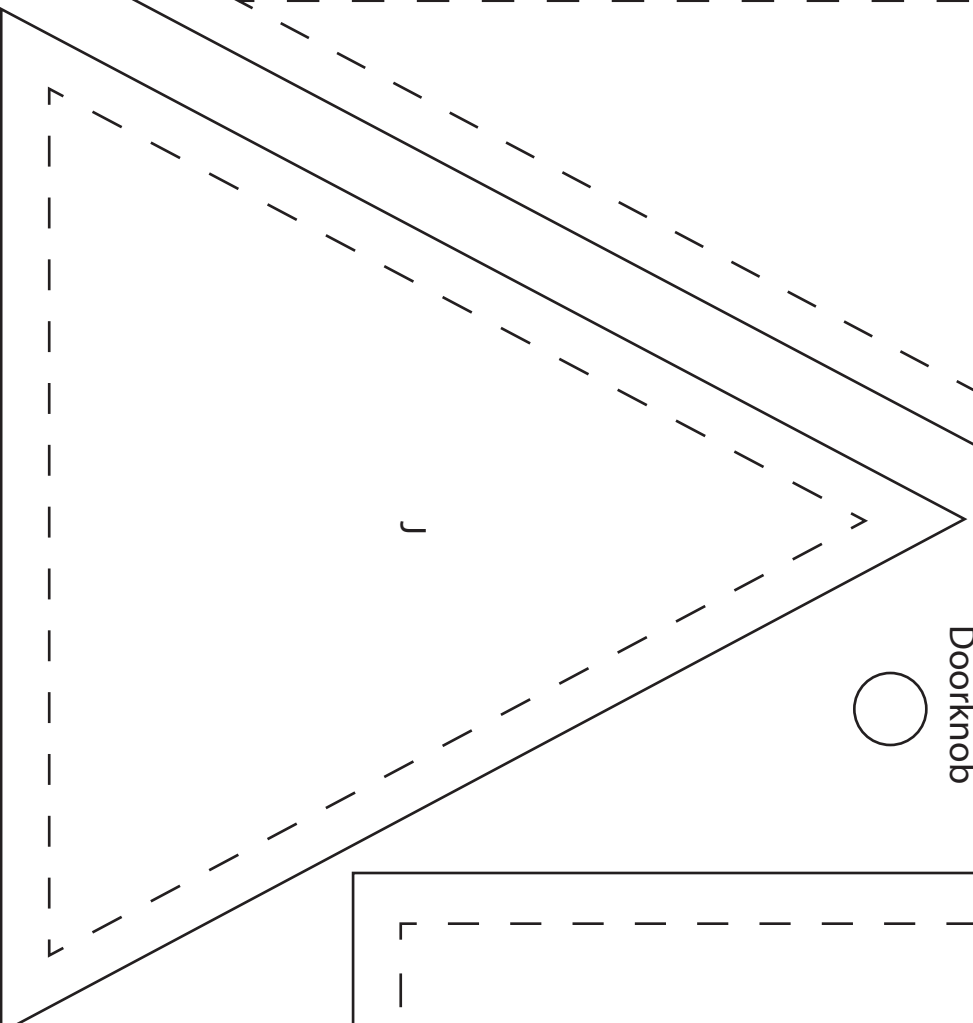
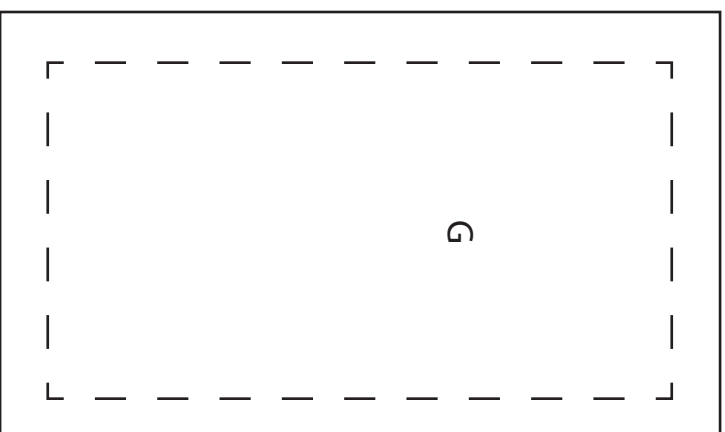
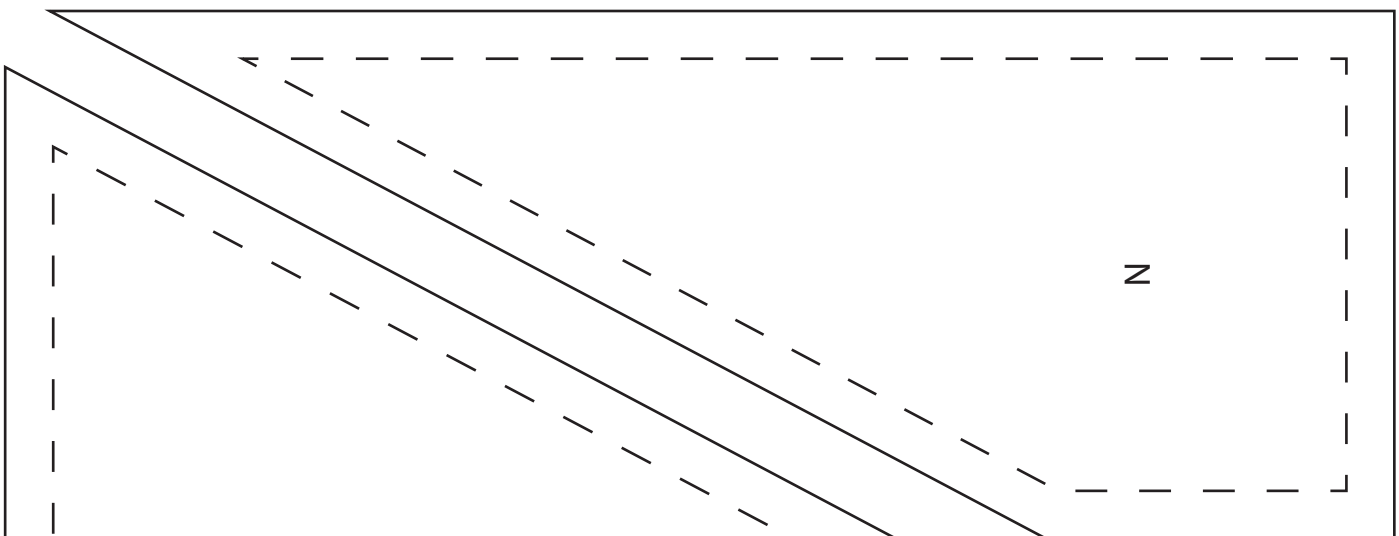
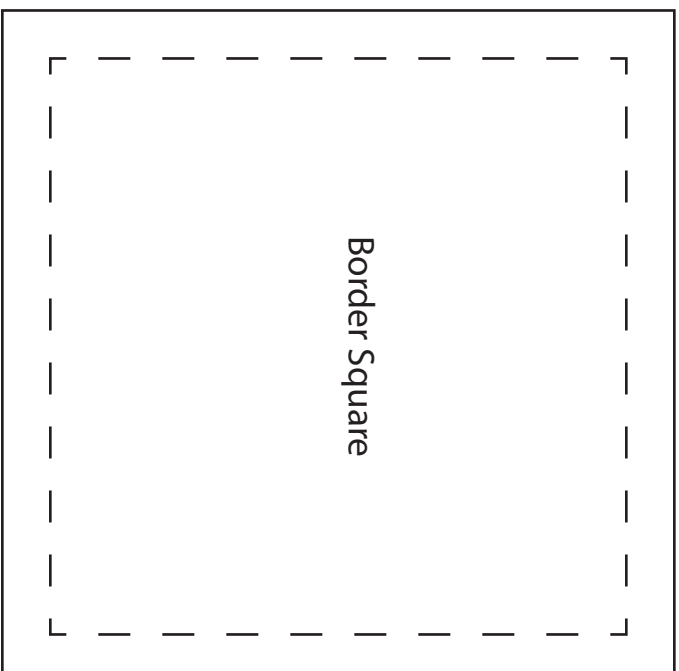
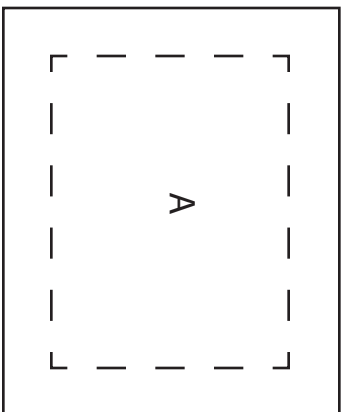
### **Borders**

1. Sew the short Bat Borders to the sides of the center.
2. Sew the long Bat Borders to the top and bottom.
3. Sew the short black Border to the sides of the bat border.
4. Sew the long black Border to the top and bottom.
5. Arrange the Border Squares around the center as shown in the photo.
6. Sew 5 squares together to make the side borders. Sew 15 squares together to make the top and bottom borders.
7. Sew the side border the side edges of the black border. Sew the top and bottom borders to the edges matching the seams.

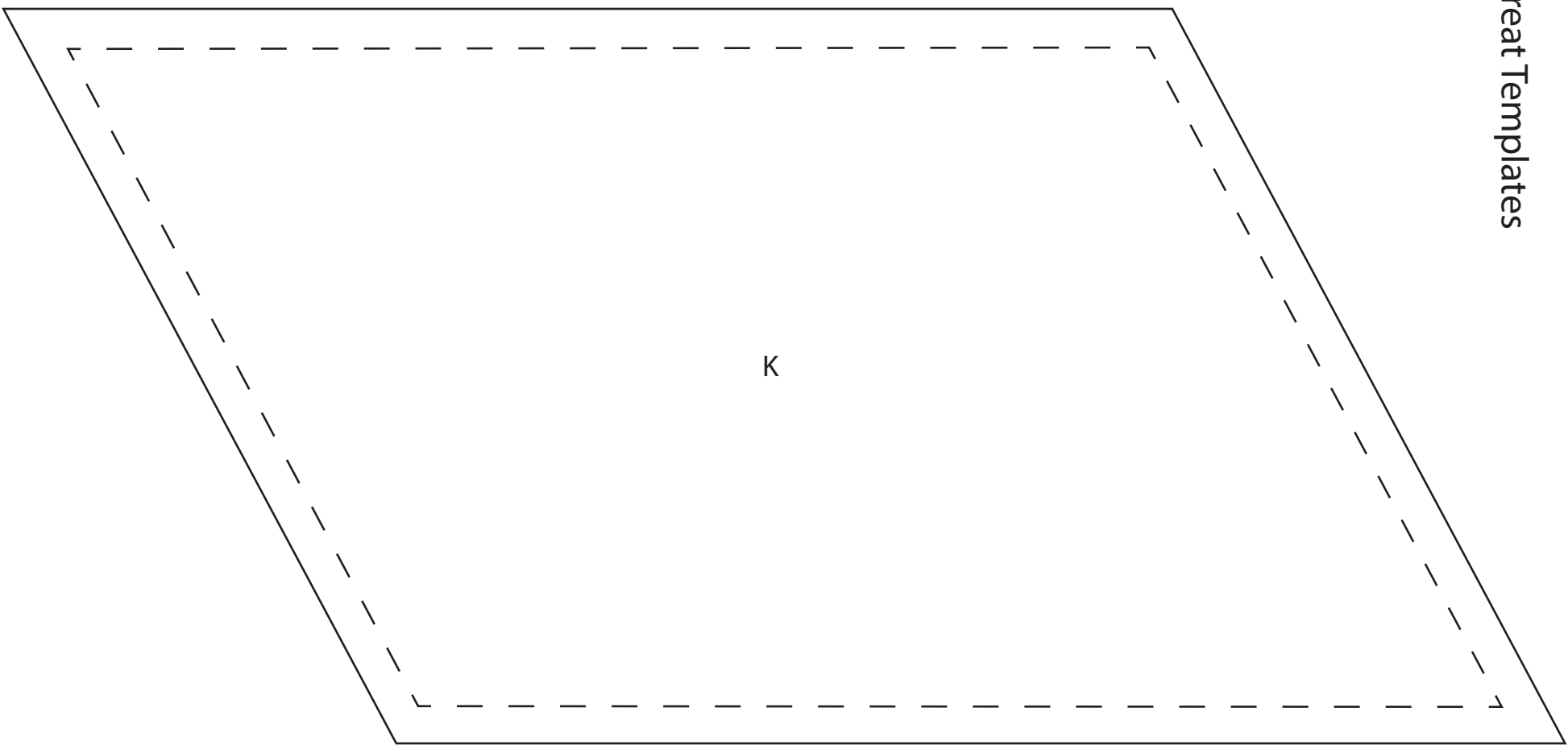
### **Layer, Quilt and Bind your quilt.**

When quilting is complete, trim the batting and backing  $\frac{1}{4}$ " larger than the edge of the border squares. Sew the binding to the edge of the wall hanging using  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance.

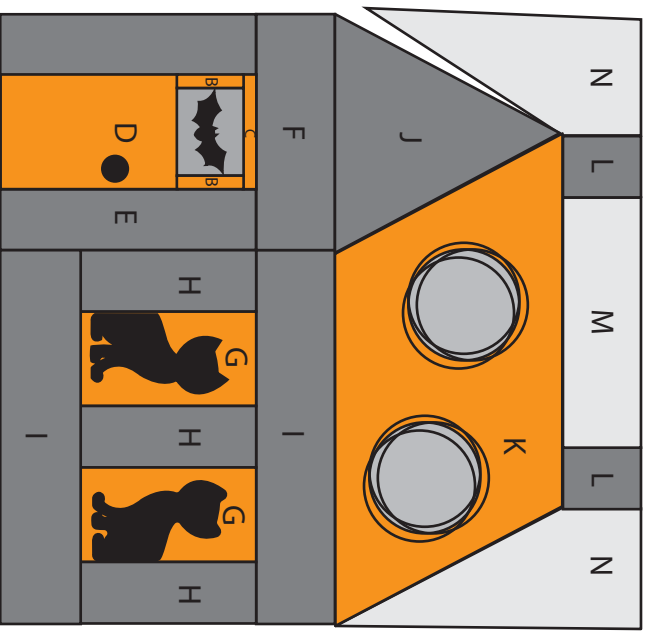
