

Cutting instructions

Materials

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	CM0376-Creamsicle Fairy Frost-Creamsicle	Fat Quarter	• Cut two 8 ½" squares.
(B)	CM0376-Spice Fairy Frost-Spice	Fat Quarter	• Cut four 8 ½" squares .
(C)	CM0376-Tangerine Fairy Frost-Tangerine	Fat Quarter	• Cut four 8 ½" squares.
(D)	CM0376-Blood Fairy Frost-Blood	Fat Quarter	• Cut two 8 ½" squares.
(E)	CM0376-Sunshine Fairy Frost-Sunshine	Fat Quarter	• Cut four 8 ½" squares.
(F)	CM0376-Clementine Fairy Frost-Clementine	Fat Quarter	• Cut four 8 ½" squares.
(G)	CM0376-Glass Fairy Frost-Glass	Fat Quarter	• Cut three 8 ½" squares.
(H)	CM0376-Turquoise Fairy Frost-Turquoise	Fat Quarter	• Cut three 8 ½" squares.
(1)	CM0376-Avocado Fairy Frost-Avocado	Fat Quarter	• Cut three 8 ½" squares.
(J)	CM0376-Hollyberry Fairy Frost-Hollyberry	Fat Quarter	• Cut two 8 ½" squares.
(K)	CM0376-Papaya Fairy Frost-Papaya	Fat Quarter	• Cut four 8 ½" squares.
(L)	CM0376-Butter Fairy Frost-Butter	Fat Quarter	• Cut four 8 ½" squares.
(M)	CM0376-Sunny Fairy Frost-Sunny	Fat Quarter	• Cut four 8 ½" squares .
(N)	CM0376-Celery Fairy Frost-Celery	Fat Quarter	• Cut three 8 ½" squares.
(O)	CM0376-Calypso Fairy Frost-Calypso	Fat Quarter + ½ yard	 Cut three 8 ½" squares. Cut five 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
(P)	CM0376-Cherry Fairy Frost-Cherry	Fat Quarter	• Cut four 8 ½" squares.
(Q)	CM0376-Apple Fairy Frost-Apple	Fat Quarter	• Cut two 8 ½" squares.
(R)	CM0376-Cloud Fairy Frost-Cloud	Fat Quarter	• Cut two 8 ½" squares.
(S)	CM0376-Mermaid Fairy Frost-Mermaid	Fat Quarter	• Cut one 8 ½" square.
(T)	CM0376-Grass Fairy Frost-Grass	Fat Quarter	• Cut three 8 ½" squares.
(U)	CM0376-Whirlpool Fairy Frost-Whirlpool	Fat Quarter	• Cut three 8 ½" squares.
(V)	CM0376-Evergreen Fairy Frost-Evergreen	Fat Quarter	• Cut three 8 ½" squares.
(W)	CM0376-Aqua Fairy Frost-Aqua	Fat Quarter	• Cut three 8 ½" squares.
Backir	CM0376-Spice Fairy Frost-Spice	3 yards	• Cut one two 48" x WOF pieces. Sew the pieces together and cut one 48" x 64" piece for the backing.

You will also need:

^{• 48&}quot; x 64" batting, fusible web, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat-




Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Block Assembly

- 1. Cut thirty-five 8 ½" squares of fusible web. Following the manufacturer's instructions and using the center marks on the template to trace thirty-five templates.
- 2. Center each piece of fusible web onto the wrong side of the 8 ½" squares as listed on the template. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics. Cut out each template on the drawn lines. Note the gray area on the template are the waste area and the frame with the cut out flower is the piece used on the blocks.
- 3. Refer to the Figures 1-20 to pair up the templates with remaining 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Center the template piece onto the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square aligning all the edges. Following the manufacturer's instructions and press the pieces together.
- 4. Finish the inside raw edges of each flower and dots with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch. You do not need to finish the outer edge of the blocks since these edges will be caught in the seam when sewn together.






Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 5. Refer to the quilt layout for block placement. Sew together five assorted blocks to make each row. Make seven rows total.
- 6. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.
- 7. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 8. Sew the five 2 ½" x WOF Fabric O binding strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
- 9. Bind as desired.
