



FAT QUARTERS 3-1/2 YARDS 5/8 YARD 5-1/4 YARDS

OF BOLTS FOR 12 KITS

16 BOLTS (3 YARDS EACH SKU) 4 BOLTS (42 YARDS) 1 BOLT (7-1/2 YARDS) 5 BOLTS (63 YARDS) 26 BOLTS (21 W/O BACK)

OF BOLTS FOR 24 KITS

16 BOLTS (6 YARDS EACH SKU) 7 BOLTS (84 YARDS) 1 BOLT (15 YARDS) 9 BOLTS (126 YARDS) 33 BOLTS (24 W/O BACK)

MAGIC STARS 2 QUILT

Yardage Requirements:

¼ yard of 15 print fabrics 3½ yards of white fabric ¾ yard binding 5½ yards backing

Cutting Instructions Per Block:

Make 15 **Block A** blocks
Make 15 **Block B** blocks
(Each ¼ yard cut makes one Block A and one Block B.)


Block A (white star) blocks:

From each **print background** fabric cut:

- (1) 7½" x 7½" square
- (4) 43/8" x 43/8" squares

From white star fabric cut:

- (1) 8¼" x 8¼" square
- (4) 4" x 4" squares



Block B (white background) blocks: From the **white background** fabric cut:

- (1) 7½" x 7½" square
- (4) 4%" x 4%" square

From each **print star** fabric cut:

- (1) 81/4" x 81/4" square
- (4) 4" x 4" squares





Block Assembly:

Following instructions to make one Magic star quilt block:

Draw a line on the wrong side of all the 4%" x 4%" squares. Lay two of those squares corner to corner (they will overlap in the center) on the 8%" x 8%" background fabric.

Sew ¼" on each side of the line.






Press seams towards small triangles, as shown below.




Lay final two 4%" squares on the bottom corner of the flying geese units. Sew ¼" on each side of the line. Cut on the marked line.



Press seams towards the small triangles.









Flying geese units will measure 4" x 7½"

Trim as needed.

Gather the 4" squares to complete the Star Block. Assemble block and press as in the direction of the arrows.





Unfinished block measures 14½"

Quilt Assembly:

Arrange blocks so there are 5 blocks across and 6 blocks down alternating between Block A and B blocks.

Sew the blocks together to form rows.

Then join the rows together to complete the top.

Quilt as desired.

From Binding Fabric Cut:

(9) 21/4" by WOF

Bind and use with love.
