## Fabric Requirements

Kashmir Gardens Fabric by Michael Miller
Refer to photo for fabric placement. Make plastic templates for diamond, large print triangle and medium print triangle to fussy cut fabrics.


## Additional Requirements:

$3-1 / 4$ yards backing fabric, 63 " $\times 73^{\prime \prime}$ batting, thread to match fabrics, freezer paper, template plastic, rotary cutter, ruler and mat, sewing machine, iron and basic sewing supplies.

## Directions

## Applique

1. Trace 15 leaves onto freezer paper and cut out. Fuse leaves shiny side down onto fern fabric (I) leaving at least $1 / 2$ " between leaves. Cut out each leaf about $3 / 16$ " around edge of paper.
2. Turn under edges of fabric along edge of freezer paper and handbaste in place mitering at points of leaves.
3. Fold bias strips in half lengthwise and sew $1 / 4$ " from fold using a short stitch length.
4. Trim raw edge to close to stitching (between $1 / 16$ "-1/8").
5. Using a bias bar, press bias strip so seam is in center of one side. Cut bias strips into (15) 6" long stems.

6. Trace placement for leaf and stem to 4-1/8" white squares (H).
7. Pin stems along curved line on square. Sew in place by hand or machine. Pin a leaf to each square. Sew in place by hand or machine.


## Peony Blocks

Sew all seams right sides together using $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

1. Sew diamonds together in pairs beginning at the corner of the seamline on the side edge.
2. Sew the seamline of one diamond to one edge of a small square.
3. Sew the seamline of the other diamond to the adjacent edge on the square.

4. Sew a small triangle to the edge of the diamond/square unit.

5. Sew two diamond pairs together ending at the corner of the seamline on the side.

6. Sew the remaining diamond/square units to the applique square.

7. Sew the halves of the blocks together beginning at the corner of the seamline of the diamonds.

Sew a large white triangle between the points of the diamonds to complete the block.

## Quilt Center

1. Following the layout diagram on page 5 , arrange the blocks and the large and small print triangles for each row. Sew the triangles to each block.
2. Sew the triangles and blocks in each row together.
3. Sew the $1-1 / 2$ " Ascot (D) strips together along the ends. Cut (6) strips the length of the rows of blocks. Sew the strips to the edge of the rows.
4. Trim the Lacery (C) vertical strips to the length of the rows of blocks. Sew the rows of blocks to the edge of the vertical strips.
5. Cut (2) 1-1/2" Ascot (D) strips the lenth of the top snd bottom edge. Sew the strips to the top and bottom edges.

## Borders

1. Sew the ends of the Lacery (C) partial WOF $x 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ matching the print along the edge of the stripes.
2. Measure the side edges of the quilt center and add 5-1/4". Mark this length along the inner edge of the border fabric centered over a black and white stripe. Cut side borders diagonally from these points (so outer edge of border is longer).
3. Measure the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Mark this length along the inner edge of the border fabric with centered over a floral stripe. Cut the top and bottom borders diagonally from these points (so outer edge of border is longer).
4. Sew the Lacery borders to the edges of the quilt beginning and ending $1 / 4$ " from the edges of the quilt center. Sew the borders together along the diagonal ends.
5. Sew the ends of the Kashmir Rose borders together matching the prints.
6. Measure the side edges of the Lacery border. Cut two side borders this length. Sew the side edges of the quilt.
7. Measure the top and bottom edges. Cut to borders this length. Sew to the top and bottom edges.
