Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

| (C) | DC7846-Flower Pixie Dust-Flower | $\frac{2}{3}$ yard | • See instructions to cut one Ray #1. |
| (D) | DC7846-Glow Pixie Dust-Glow | $\frac{5}{8}$ yard | • See instructions to cut one Ray #2. |
| (E) | DC7846-Leaf Pixie Dust-Leaf | $\frac{5}{8}$ yard | • See instructions to cut one Ray #3. |
| (F) | DC7846-Aqua Pixie Dust-Aqua | $\frac{1}{2}$ yard | • See instructions to cut one Ray #4. |
| (G) | DC7846-Sky Pixie Dust-Sky | $\frac{1}{2}$ yard | • See instructions to cut one Ray #5. |
| (H) | DC7846-Twinkle Pixie Dust-Twinkle | $\frac{1}{2}$ yard | • See instructions to cut one Ray #6. |
| Backing | CM8322-Sky Rainbow Hair, Don't Care-Sky | 1 yard | • See instructions to cut the backing. |

You will also need:

- Poly fil, fusible web, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Disclaimers

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Pillow Assembly

1. Enlarge templates 400%.
2. Following the manufacturer's instructions trace each template onto the paper side of the fusible web.
3. Roughly cut out each shape outside the drawn lines. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabric as listed on each template. Cut out each shape on the drawn lines.
4. Press one Fabric C Ray #1 to the background (Fig. 1).
5. Press one Fabric D Ray #2 to the background slightly overlapping Ray #1 (Fig. 2).

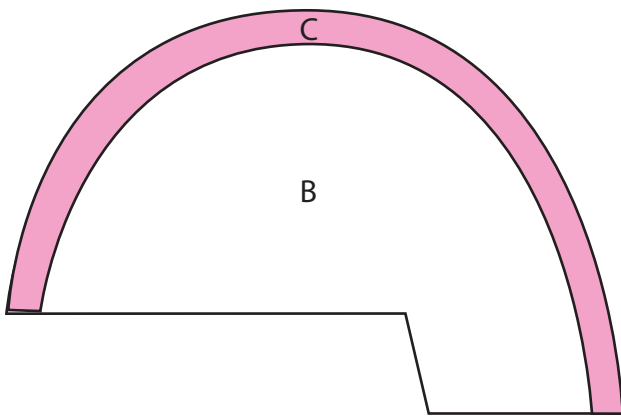

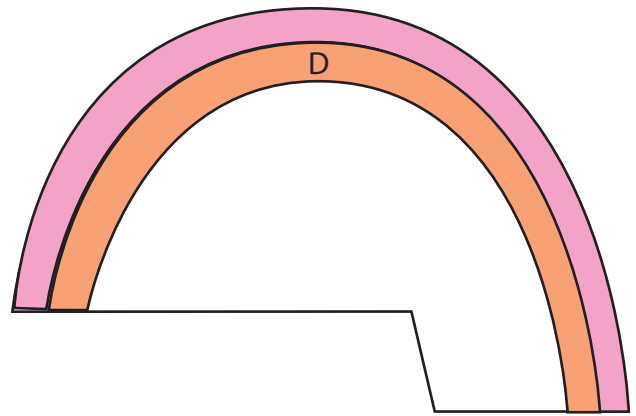

6. Repeat Step 5 to continue to add the rays to the background in numerical order to complete Unit 1 (Fig. 3).
7. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
8. Follow Figure 4 to press the Fabric A large cloud to the lower right corner of the rainbow.

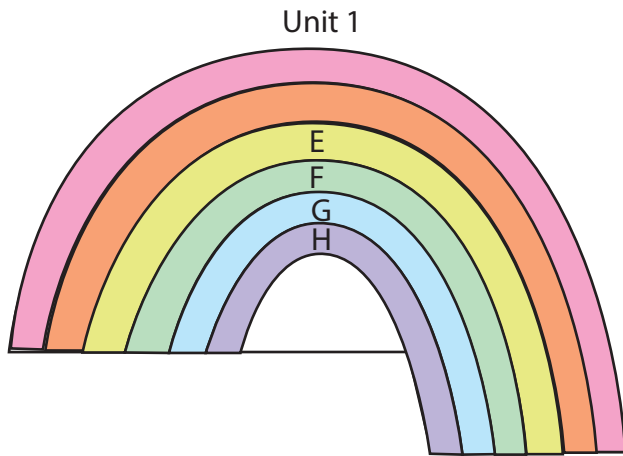

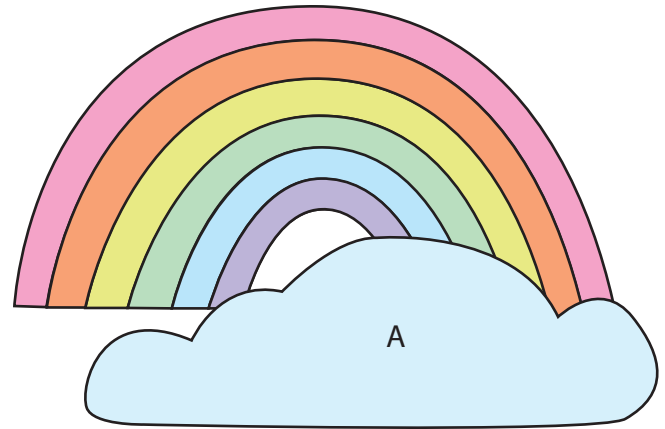

9. Follow Figure 5 to press the Fabric A small cloud to the lower left corner of the rainbow.

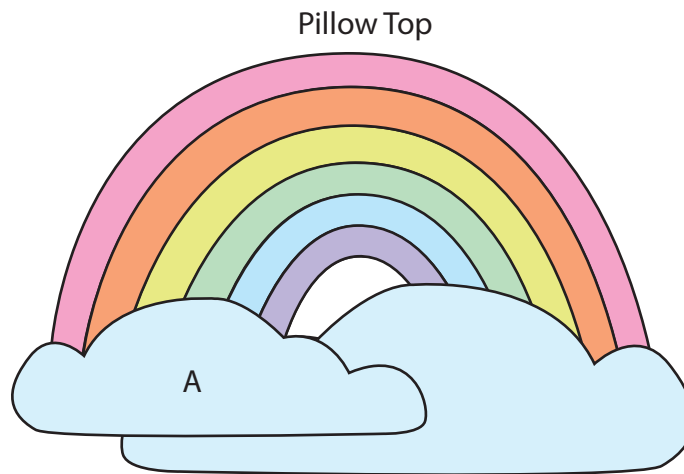
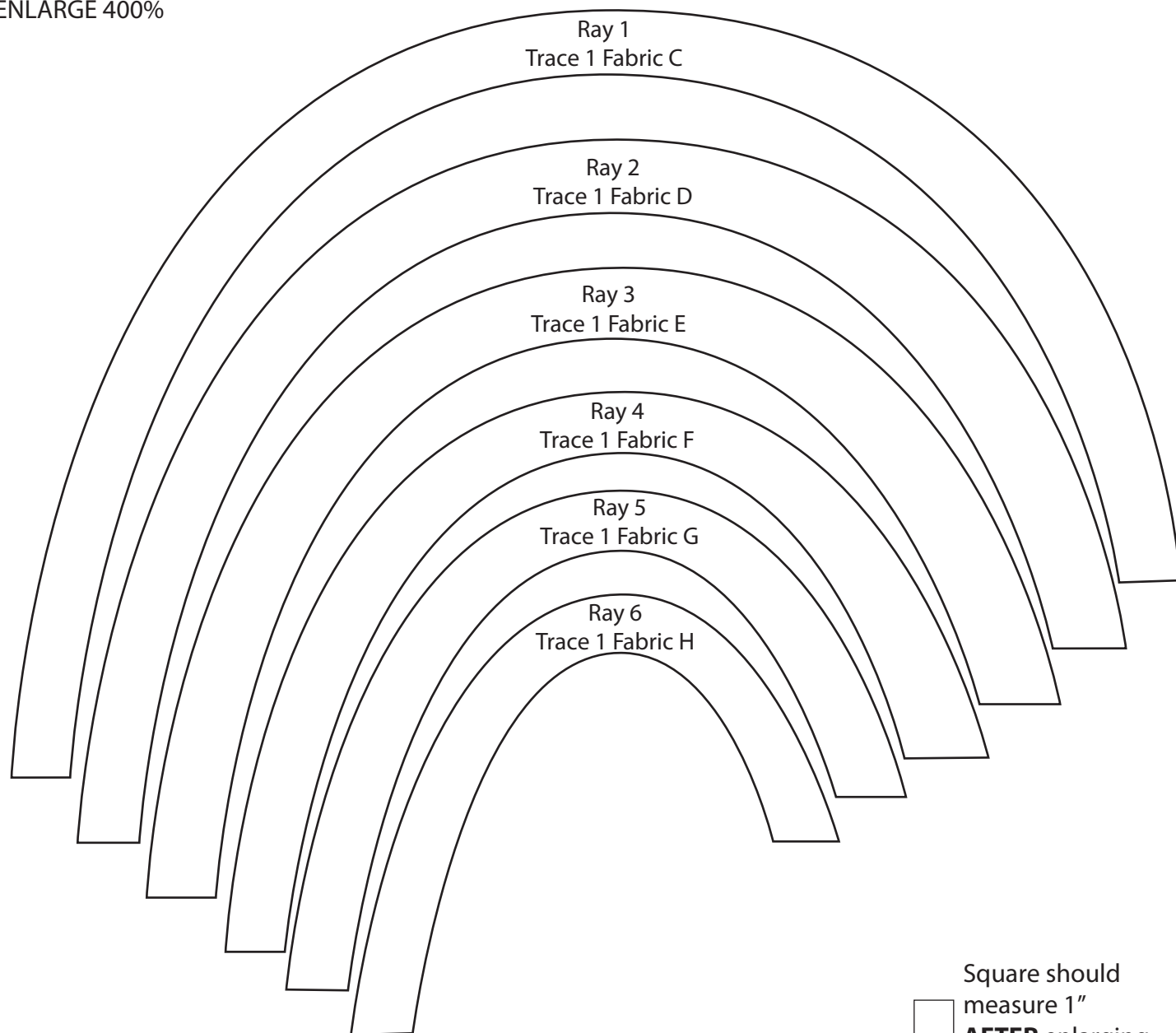


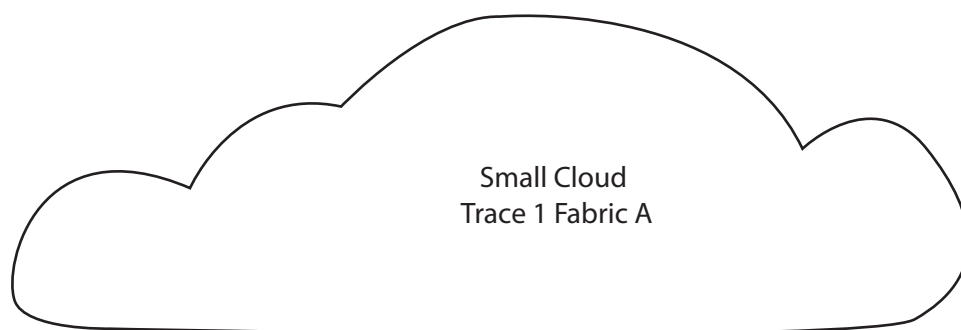

10. Place the pillow top on the backing fabric right sides together. Cut the backing fabric to match the pillow top.
11. Pin the two layers together and sew the layers together, leaving a 4" opening for turning and stuffing.
12. Turn the pillow right side out and stuff with poly fil. Stitch the opening closed.
