**Also Needed:** 45" X 60" batting, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, mat, and thread to match.

**Note**: This quilt is made with (6) 14" compound blocks (multiple units) to create the pattern.

\* Pieced for length

\*\* Fat 1/8 measures 9" X 22"

#### **Directions:**

- 1. To make (1) sawtooth unit 4 ½" x 6 ½" Place one CM0376 5" square right sides together on the top of (1) CX8410 5" square. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Sew ¾"on each side of the drawn line. Cut along the diagonal to make (2) right square triangles (RST). Trim each square to an accurate 4 ½" square. Subcut the square into (3) 1 1/2" W x 4 1/2" H strips. Set aside. Repeat using CX8405, CX7161, SC5333 Lemon, SC5333 Grass, SC5333 Princess 5" squares with CX8410 5" squares. Yield: (8) RST of each color combo. Subcut RST into 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips cut four RST of each color with right facing points and four with left facing points. To assemble one sawtooth unit of (6) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips choose one of each color combination. Graduate the points small to large in the center and back to small using (6) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips. Refer to photo. Make a total of (24) sawtooth units. Set aside.
- 2. Place one 2 ½" square right sides together on top of one corner of one CM8072 4 ½" square. Sew diagonally across the corner. Press open. Trim excess fabric from the back. Make (6) each using SC5333 Lemon, SC5333 Princess, CM0376 Avocado, and K1063 Hyacinth 2 ½" squares.
- 3. To assemble (1) 14 ½" unfinished compound block using one of each color of 4 ½" CM8072 square. Sew one 4 ½" square to each end of one 4 ½" x 6 ½" sawtooth unit. Keep the contrast corner to the outside edge of the block as shown. Each outside corner should be a different color. Make 2 strips. Set aside. Sew one sawtooth unit to the top and bottom of one DC8432 6 ½" square. Sew one sawtooth strip to each side of the center unit as shown. Keep colored corners to the outside. Refer to photo. Make (6) 14 ½" compound blocks total.
- 4. Sew together the (6) 14 ½" blocks into one 28 ½" W x 42 ½" H quilt top using (2) blocks in a row and making (3) rows.
- 5. Sew one CX8386 1 ½" x 42 ½" strip to each side of the quilt. Sew one CX8386 1 ½" x 30 ½" strip to the top and bottom.
- 6. Sew one CM8072 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one CM8072 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (pieced for length) to each side.
- 7. Sew one DC8432 4 ½" x 32 ½" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one DC8432 4 ½" x 54 ½" strip, pieced for length to each side.
- 8. Layer CX8410 44" x 1 5/8" yard backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 9. Quilt as desired.
- 10. Bind quilt using CX8386 2 ½" strips pieced as needed for length.
