# **Block Assembly**

For each block, following the order specified in the Block Assembly Details table, cut the length of fabric specified for each log from the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip of the corresponding color fabric, one log at a time. Stitch all pieces with right sides together using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance in a counter-clockwise direction, following the order specified in the Block Assembly Details Table. Press all seams toward the most recently added log. Block 1 assembly is shown. After Block 1 is pieced, move on to the cutting and assembly for Block 2.

- 1. Measure and cut from the 3 ½" x WOF strips of the colors specified the lengths for Log 1 and Log 2. Add Log 2 to Log 1.
- 2. Measure and cut Log 3 from the 3 ½" x WOF strip of the color specified for Log 3. Add Log 3.
- 3. Measure and cut Log 4 from the 3 ½" x WOF strip of the color specified for Log 4. Add Log 4.
- 4. Measure and cut Log 5 from the 3 ½" x WOF strip of the color specified for Log 5. Add Log 5.
- 5. Measure and cut Log 6 from the 3 ½" x WOF strip of the color specified for Log 6. Add Log 6.
- 6. Measure and cut Log 7 from the 3 ½" x WOF strip of the color specified for Log 7. Add Log 7.
- 7. Measure and cut Log 8 from the 3 ½" x WOF strip of the color specified for Log 8. Add Log 8.
- 8. Measure and cut Log 9 from the 3 ½" x WOF strip of the color specified for Log 9. Add Log 9.




Figure 1: Add Log 2 to Log 1




Figure 3: Add Log 4




Figure 4: Add Log 5




Figure 5: Add Log 6




Figure 6: Add Log 7




Figure 7: Add Log 8




Figure 9: Add Log 9




## **Quilt Assembly**

Sew together the rows in each section, carefully orienting blocks as shown. The label for each block is on the bottom of the block, along the edge of Log 9. Press seams as indicated by the arrows.


**Section A:** Sew together Blocks 4, 3, 7, 2, 6, 10, 1, 5, 9, and 13 as shown.




Section B: Sew together Blocks 8, 15, 12, 22, 19, and 16 as shown.




Section C: Sew together Blocks 23, 24, and 20 as shown.




Section D: Sew together Blocks 25, 18, 21, 11, 14, and 17 as shown.




**Sections A and B:** Sew together Sections A and B, adding a  $1" \times 60 \frac{1}{2}"$  black strip. Press toward the black strip.




**Sections C and D:** Sew together Sections C and D, adding a 1"  $\times$  45  $\frac{1}{2}$ " black strip. Press toward the black strip.



**Quilt Assembly:** Sew together Sections A&B and Sections C&D, adding a  $1" \times 76"$  black strip. Press toward the black strip.



**Quilt Trimming:** Trim the outer edges of the blocks so that finished quilt is square trimming where the outer blocks intersect and the outer edge is straight, as shown. The trimmed fabric is scrap.
