

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A	PINK - Fussy cut (32) 2-1/2" squares BLUE - Fussy cut (32) 2-1/2" squares (4) 2-1/2" X WOF strips, BINDING
В	PINK - (4) 2-1/2" X WOF strips, BINDING (7) 1" squares for Applique Shape 3 BLUE - (7) 1" squares for Applique Shape 3
С	BOTH - Fussy cut (7) 4" X 5" rectangles for Appliques Shape 2 Fussy cut (8) 2-1/2" squares
D	BOTH - (2) 2-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" X 18-1/2" rectangles, SASHING (1) 2-1/2" X WOF strip, subcut (7) 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangles for Applique Shape 1 (3) 2-1/2" X WOF strips, BORDER
E	BOTH - (2) 6-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (7) 6-1/2" squares and (28) 2-1/2" squares (1) 2-1/2" X WOF strip, subcut (4) 2-1/2" squares

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED: 2/3 YD Fusible web Product



BLOCK A ASSEMBLY:


- 1. Sew (1) A 2-1/2" square to each side of (1) E 2-1/2" square to create UNIT 1. Make (14).
- 2. Sew (1) **E** 2-1/2" square to each side of (1) **C** 2-1/2" square to create **UNIT 2**. Make (7).

3. Sew (1) **UNIT 1** to the top and bottom of (1) **UNIT 2** to create **BLOCK A**. Square to 6-1/2", make (7).






BLOCK A (make 7)



BLOCK B ASSEMBLY:

- 4. Trace (7) each of the **1**, **2** and **3 applique shapes** onto the paper side of your favorite fusible web product, then cut out the shapes approximately 1/4 inch outside of the drawn lines.
- 5. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse shapes to the wrong sides of **B**, **C** and **D fabrics**. Allow to cool, then carefully cut out the shapes on the drawn lines.
- 6. Peel off paper backing, then arrange onto (1) **E** 6-1/2" square as shown. Fuse into place to create **BLOCK B**. Square to 6-1/2", make (7). Note: After fusing appliques, you may want to finish the raw edges using a zig zag or buttonhole stitch.




QUILT ASSEMBLY:

- 7. Sew blocks together into rows as follows:
 Rows 1, 3 and 5: BLOCK **A** BLOCK **B** BLOCK **A**Rows 2 and 4: BLOCK **B** BLOCK **A** BLOCK **B**
- 8. Sew rows and (4) **D** 2-1/2" X 18-1/2" **SASHING** strips together to create QUILT CENTER.
- 9. Sew (3) **D** 2-1/2" X WOF strips together via short ends using a straight seam. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 18-1/2"), cut (2) **D** strips to fit and sew onto top and bottom of QUILT CENTER. Measure sides (ours is 42-1/2"), cut (2) **D** strips to fit and sew to sides of QUILT CENTER.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using four $\bf A$ (blue) or $\bf B$ (pink) 2-1/4" strips.
