Α	(1) 3-1/4" X WOF strip, subcut (4) Template A and (4) Template B (2) 5-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (8) 5-1/2" squares (6) 2-1/4" X WOF strips, BINDING
В	(3) 3-1/4" X WOF strips, subcut (16) Template A and (16) Template B (5) 1-1/2" X WOF strips, BORDER
С	(3) 5-3/4" WOF strips, subcut (20) Template C
D	(3) 3-1/4" X WOF strips, subcut (16) Template A and (16) Template B (2) 5-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (8) 5-1/2" X 10-1/2" rectangles
E	(2) 5-3/4" WOF strips, subcut (16) Template C
F	(1) 10-1/2" X WOF strip, subcut (4) 10-1/2" squares (5) 4-1/2" X WOF strips, BORDER
G	Fussy cut (4) 5-1/2" squares
Н	Fussy cut (5) 5-1/2" squares




#### **UNIT ASSEMBLY:**

1. Following unit images below, sew (1) Left Triangle (Template B) to left side of (1) Center Triangle (Template C). Press, the sew (1) Right Triangle (Template A) to right side. Make (4) of each unit, square all to 5-1/2".








#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY:**

BLOCK 1: Sew (1) UNIT 4 and (1) UNIT 7 together as shown, then sew (1) D 5-1/2" X 10-1/2" rectangle to the left side to complete BLOCK 1. Square to 10-1/2", make (2).





3. **BLOCK 2:** Sew (1) **UNIT 3** and (1) **UNIT 6** together as shown, then sew (1) **D** 5-1/2" X 10-1/2" rectangle to the right side to complete **BLOCK 2**. Square to 10-1/2", make (2).





4. **BLOCK 3:** Sew (1) **UNIT 8** to (1) **UNIT 5** as shown. Square to 5-1/2" X 10-1/2", make (2).







QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper unit/block placement and rotation.

- 5. Sew pieces, units and blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.
  - Row 1: A square UNIT 1 D rectangle UNIT 9 D rectangle UNIT 2 A square
  - Row 2: UNIT 2 H square UNIT 3 UNIT 6 G square UNIT 7 UNIT 4 H square UNIT 1
  - Row 3: BLOCK 1 F square BLOCK 3 F square BLOCK 2
  - Row 4: UNIT 9 G square UNIT 8 UNIT 5 H square UNIT 5 UNIT 8 G square UNIT 9
  - Row 5: BLOCK 2 F square BLOCK 3 F square BLOCK 1
  - Row 6: UNIT 1 H square UNIT 4 UNIT 7 G square UNIT 6 UNIT 3 H square UNIT 2
  - Row 7: A square UNIT 2 D rectangle UNIT 9 D rectangle UNIT 1 A square


#### **BORDER ASSEMBLY:**

- 6. Sew (5) **B** 1-1/2" X WOF strips together via short ends. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 45-1/2"), cut (2) **B** strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom (ours is 47-1/2"), cut (2) **B** strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- 7. Sew (5) **F** 4-1/2" X WOF strips together via short ends. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 47-1/2") and cut (2) **F** strips to fit, set aside. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 47-1/2"), cut (2) **F** strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt.
- 8. Sew (1) A 4-1/2" square to each end of F 4-1/2" X (47-1/2") strips set aside in Step 7, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using (6) A 2-1/4" strips.




### **QUILT DIAGRAM**
