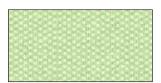

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A	FUSSY CUT (13) 5-1/2" squares for block centers.
В	(5) 6-1/2" x WOF strips; from two strips subcut (24) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles. Save three remaining strips for strip piecing. (4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (26) 4-1/2" squares and cut once diagonally to yield (52) Fabric B triangles.
С	(2) 5-3/4" x WOF strips; subcut (14) 5-3/4" squares and cut once diagonally to yield (28) Fabric C triangles.
D	(2) 5-3/4" x WOF strips; subcut (12) 5-3/4" squares and cut once diagonally to yield (24) Fabric C triangles.
Е	(7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.
F	(4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.
G	(10) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Set (4) aside for strip piecing and (6) aside for binding.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Sew a Fabric B triangle to one side of a Fabric A 5-1/2" square. Press toward Fabric B triangle. Sew a Fabric B triangle to remaining three sides, pressing toward Fabric B triangles after adding each one. Square block to measure 7-1/2" square.



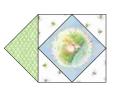






7-1/2" square Make 13

Sew a Fabric C triangle to one side of 7-1/2" square unit. Press toward Fabric C triangle. Sew a Fabric C triangle to remaining three sides, pressing toward Fabric C triangles after adding each one. Square block to measure 10-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of (13) blocks.



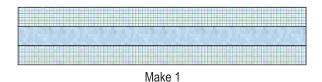

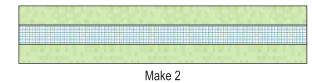
Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of a 2-1/2" Fabric E strip. Press toward Fabric G strips. Make (1) strip set. Cross-cut strip set to yield (12) 2-1/2" segments.

Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of a 2-1/2" Fabric G strip. Press toward Fabric F strips. Make (2) strip sets. Cross-cut strip sets to yield (24) 2-1/2" segments.

Arrange (1) Fabric E/G unit and (2) Fabric F/G units as shown below. Sew together and press toward Fabric F/G units. Repeat to make a total of (12) nine-patch blocks.

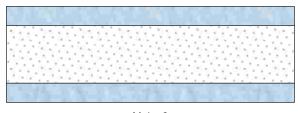

Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of a 6-1/2" Fabric B strip. Press toward Fabric E strips. Make (2) strip sets. Cross-cut strip sets to yield (24) 2-1/2" segments.

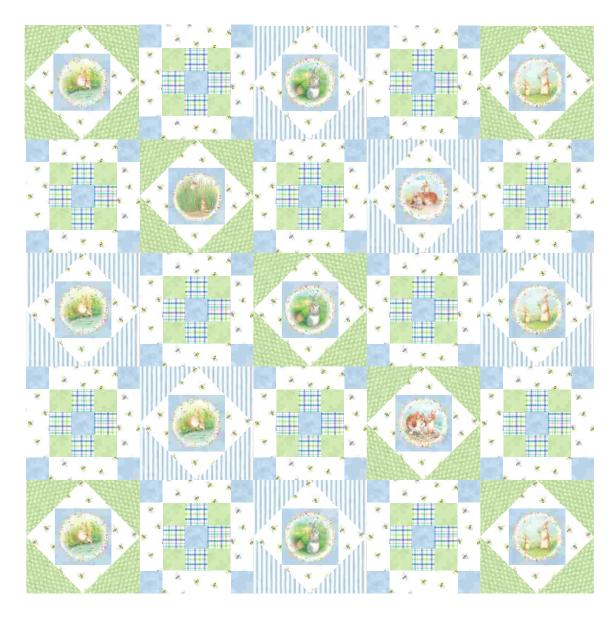


2-1/2" Cut 24 Sew a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to each side of a nine-patch unit. Press toward Fabric B rectangles. Sew a pieced Fabric B/E unit to top of block and press toward B/E unit. Sew a second Fabric B/E unit to bottom of block and press toward B/E unit. Block should measure 10-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of (12) blocks.

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10-1/2" square Make 12

Arrange all blocks as shown below. Sew together into horizontal rows. Press seams in each row in the opposite direction as the previous row. Sew rows together to complete quilt top.



Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using [6] 2-1/2" Fabric G strips.
