





ALSO NEEDED: $45'' \times 60''$ backing, $45'' \times 60''$ batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, mat, and fusible web.

OPTIONAL (but recommended): Iron-on tear-away stabilizer

* Cut vertically - One way print. Keep motifs upright.

** Pieced for length.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.


While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.


Directions:

- 1. Sew one CX1492 Luna 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the top and bottom of DC5983 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece. Sew one CX1492 Luna 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to each side. Set aside.
- 2. For stripped border sew together all width of fabric (W.O.F.) strips together in the listed order to make one 20" x W.O.F. cut into 2 ½' x 20" strips across the piecework. Piece 2 ½" strips together to make (2) 2 ½" x 24 ½" pieces. Sew one each to the top and bottom of the quilt. Make two strips 2 ½" x 44 ½". Sew to each side of the quilt.
- 3. Sew one CX1492 Luna 1" x 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one CX1492 Luna 1" x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (pieced for length) to each side.
- 4. Trace (5) shells onto the paper side of the fusible web. Following manufacturer's directions, iron onto the wrong side of K1007. Cut out. Remove paper backing. Iron one each in the center of each DC5986 Clay $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Machine satin stitch raw edges and detail lines on each shell. Set aside.
- 5. For Starfish blocks cut (8) CX3584 6 ½" squares into (4) equal parts diagonally (to make (4) triangles). Piece together (4) with stripes making a cross design and (4) with stripes making a square design. See photo. Trim each finished block to an accurate 5 ½" square. Add the Starfish CX1065 motif in the center of each block following the directions in Step #6.
- 6. Sew together six assorted 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks as shown. Make (2) rows. Sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt. Sew together the remaining 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks into (2) sets of (11). Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
- 7. For the coral branch, iron the fusible web on the wrong side of CJ4816. Referring to the photo, free-hand draw a large coral branch as shown. It does not need to be exact. Cut out. Remove paper backing. Iron coral onto the quilt top as shown. Machine satin stitch all raw edges to finish.
 - OPTIONAL (but recommended): Iron iron-on tear-away stabilizer to the back of the quilt before stitching. Stitch. Remove all traces of the stabilizer after stitching. Stabilizer improves the stitch quality and helps to eliminate any distortion.
- 8. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 9. Quilt as desired.
- 10. Bind quilt using CX4834 Teal 2 ½" strips pieced for length.
