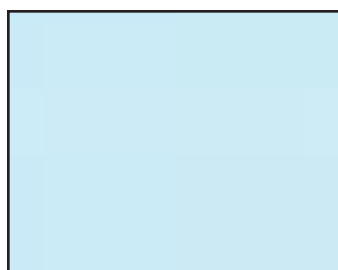

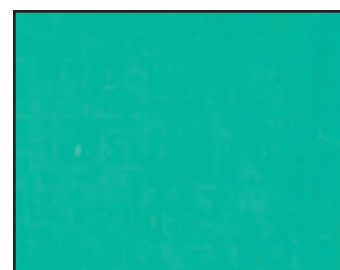

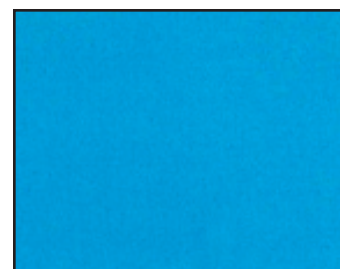

Spam Quilt

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A	(1) 9" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 9" squares.
B	(4) 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1-1/4" x 9" strips. (4) 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1-1/4" x 10-1/2" strips.
C	(2) 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1-1/4" x 9" strips. (2) 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1-1/4" x 10-1/2" strips. (5) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3" x 5-1/2" strips. (1) 3-3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3-3/8" squares.
D	(19) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (256) 3" squares. FOR BINDING: (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
E	(5) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3" x 5-1/2" strips. (1) 3-3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3-3/8" squares.
F	(3) 3-3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3-3/8" squares. (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60-1/2" strips. (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 63-1/2" strips.
G	(1) 9" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 9" squares.
H	(5) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3" x 5-1/2" strips. (1) 3-3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3-3/8" squares.
I	(1) 9" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 9" squares.
J	(2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 9" strips. (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 10-1/2" strips. (5) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3" x 5-1/2" strips.
K	(1) 9" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 9" squares.
L	(1) 3 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 3/8" squares.
Back	(2) 71" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 71" pieced backing.

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Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 1-1/4" x 9" Fabric **B** strip to each side of (1) 9" Fabric **A** square. Sew (1) 1-1/4" x 10-1/2" Fabric **B** strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric **A** square to make (1) **Unit 1** square (**Fig. 1**). Repeat to make (4) **Unit 1** squares total.

2. Repeat **Step 1** and refer to **Figures 2-4** for fabric identification and placement to make (4) **Unit 2** squares, (4) **Unit 3** squares and (4) **Unit 4** squares.

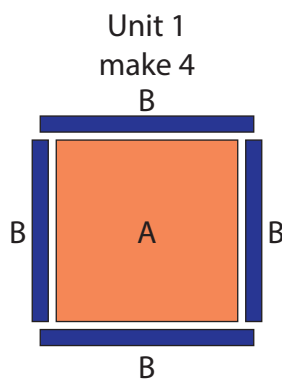

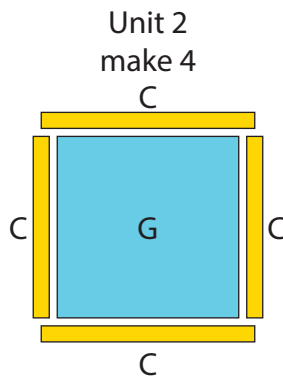

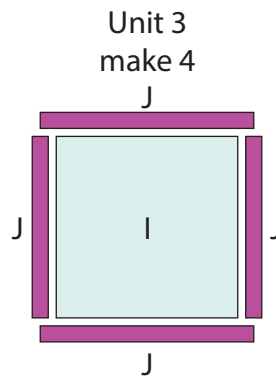

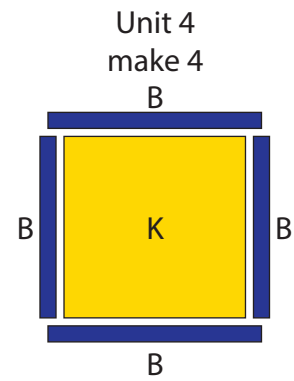

3. Place (1) 3" Fabric **D** square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5-1/2" Fabric **C** strip, right sides together (**Fig. 5**). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (**Fig. 5**). Flip open the triangle formed and press (**Fig. 6**). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

4. Place another 3" Fabric **D** square on the right side of the 3" x 5-1/2" Fabric **C** strip, right sides together (**Fig. 7**). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (**Fig. 7**). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 5** strip (**Fig. 8**).

5. Repeat **Steps 3-4** to make (32) **Unit 5** strips total.

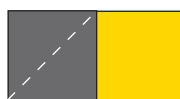

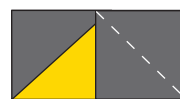

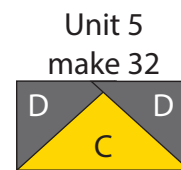

6. Repeat **Steps 3-4** and refer to **Figures 9-11** for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (32) **Unit 6** strips, (32) **Unit 7** strips and (32) **Unit 8** strips.

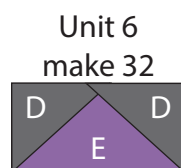

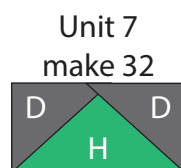

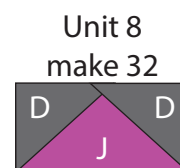

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7. Sew (2) **Unit 5** strips together end to end to make (1) **Unit 9** strip (**Fig. 12**). Repeat to make (16) **Unit 9** strips total.

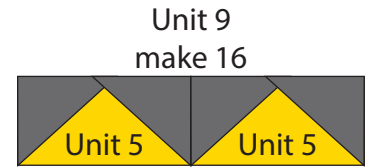

8. Repeat **Step 7** and refer to **Figures 13-15** for component identification, placement and orientation to make (16) **Unit 10** strips, (16) **Unit 11** strips and (16) **Unit 12** strips.

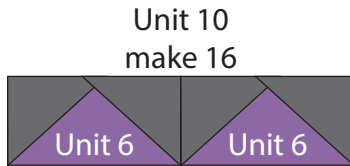

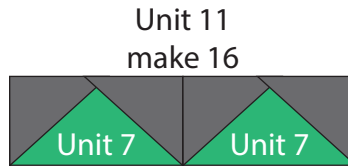

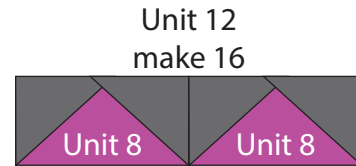

9. Place (1) 3-3/8" Fabric **E** square on top of (1) 3-3/8" Fabric **F** square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (**Fig. 16**). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (**Fig. 16**). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (**Fig. 17**) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3" square to make (2) **Unit 13** squares (**Fig. 18**). Repeat to make sixteen Unit 13 squares total.

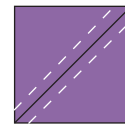

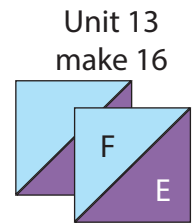

10. Repeat **Step 9** and refer to **Figures 19-21** for fabric identification and placement to make (16) **Unit 14** squares, (16) **Unit 15** squares and (16) **Unit 16** squares.

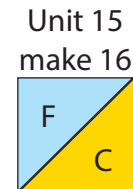

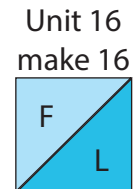

11. Sew (1) **Unit 13** square to each end of (1) **Unit 9** strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 9** strip to each side of (1) **Unit 1** square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) **Block One** square (**Fig. 22**). Repeat to make (4) **Block One** squares total.

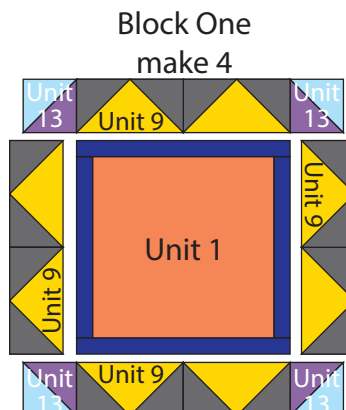

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12. Repeat **Step 11** and refer to **Figures 23-25** for component identification, placement and orientation to make (4) **Block Two** squares, (4) **Block Three** squares and (4) **Block Four** squares.

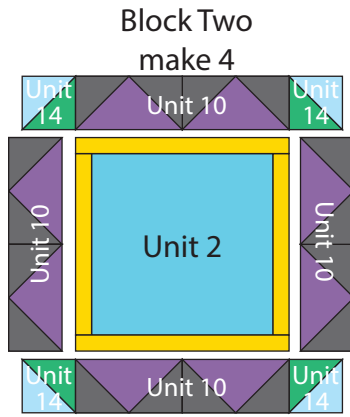

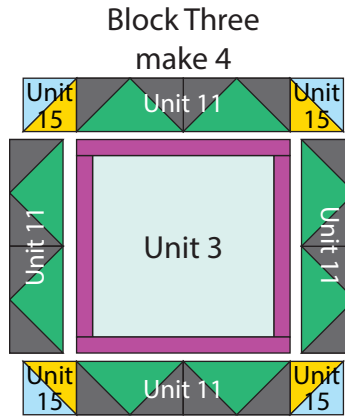

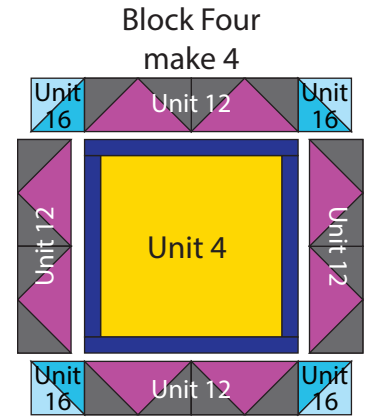

Quilt Top Assembly:

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

13. Sew together (2) **Block One** squares and (2) **Block Two** squares, alternating them, to make **Row One**.

14. Sew together (2) **Block Three** squares and (2) **Block Four** squares, alternating them, to make **Row Two**.

15. Sew together (2) **Block Two** squares and (2) **Block One** squares, alternating them, to make **Row Three**.

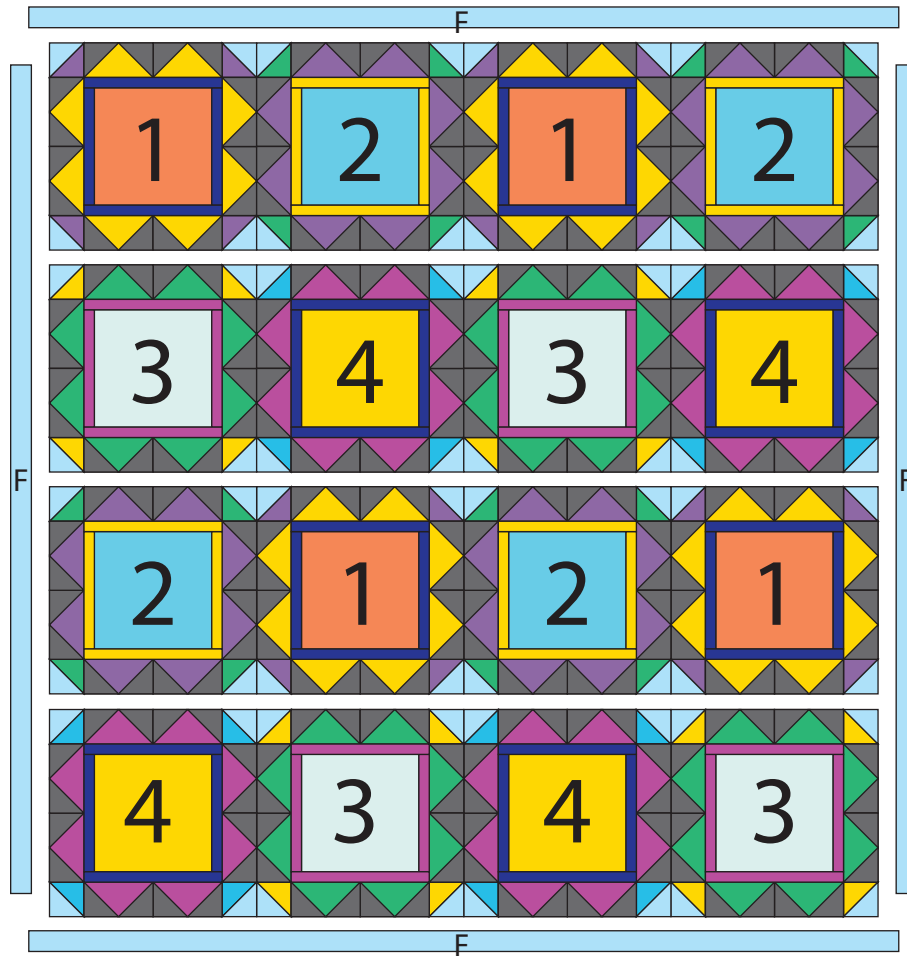
16. Sew together (2) **Block Four** squares and (2) **Block Three** squares, alternating them, to make **Row Four**.

17. Sew the (4) **Rows** together, in numerical order, to make the **Center Block**.

18. Sew (1) 2" x 60-1/2" Fabric **F** strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) 2" x 63-1/2" Fabric **F** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using (7) Fabric **D** 2-1/2" strips.
