| A | Fussy cut (1) $16^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strip centered on the large panel. Fussy cut (4) 10-1/2" squares, each centered on a square. |
| B | (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips. <br> (1) 2-1/2" $\times$ Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strips. <br> (2) 2 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2 " \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. <br> (3) $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| C | (1) 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2-1/2" squares. |
| D | (4) $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips. <br> (2) $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| E | (4) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips. <br> (2) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| F | (2) $25^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. <br> (2) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed. |
| G | Fussy cut (2) $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 49^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips each centered on an orange row. Fussy cut (2) $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips each centered on a purple row. |
| H | (1) 6-1/4" $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6-1/4" squares. |
| I | FOR BINDING: <br> (6) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding. |
| Back | (2) 62 " $\times$ WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the $62^{\prime \prime} \times 68^{\prime \prime}$ pieced backing. |

## Block Assembly:

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $16^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A large panel. Sew (1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A large panel. Trim the block to measure 19" x $25^{\prime \prime}$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ strip to each side of (1) 10-1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 13-1 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 12-1/2" square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

3. Place (1) 2-1/2" Fabric C square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 1 square, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
4. Follow Figure 5 for the seam direction to add a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{C}$ square to each of the remaining corners of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 6).

6. Sew (1) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{E}$ strip to each side of (1) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip lengthwise. Sew (1) $2-3 / 4 " \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{D}$ strip to each side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

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7. Sew (1) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{E}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip lengthwise. Sew (1) $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of the new strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 8). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly:
(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the runner top.)
8. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
9. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 49^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G orange strip to each side of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) 6-1/4" Fabric $\mathbf{H}$ square to each end of (1) $6-1 / 4 " \times 43^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{G}$ purple strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using (6) Fabric I 2-1/2" strips.
