
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



# Howl-o-Ween


KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
<b>A</b>	Fussy cut (1) 16" x 22" strip centered on the large panel. Fussy cut (4) 10-1/2" squares, each centered on a square.
<b>B</b>	(2) 2-1/2" x 22" WOF strips. (1) 2-1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut (2) 2-1/2" x 20" strips. (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 10-1/2" strips. (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 13-1/2" strips.
<b>C</b>	(1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2-1/2" squares.
<b>D</b>	(4) 2-3/4" x 25" WOF strips. (2) 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2-3/4" x 19" strips.
<b>E</b>	(4) 1-1/4" x 25" WOF strips. (2) 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1-1/4" x 19" strips.
<b>F</b>	(2) 25" x 6-1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. (2) 6-1/2" x 19" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.
<b>G</b>	Fussy cut (2) 6-1/4" x 49" LOF strips each centered on an orange row. Fussy cut (2) 6-1/4" x 43" LOF strips each centered on a purple row.
<b>H</b>	(1) 6-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6-1/4" squares.
<b>I</b>	<b>FOR BINDING:</b> (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
<b>Back</b>	(2) 62" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 68" pieced backing.

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
## Block Assembly:

**Note:** The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 22" Fabric **B** strip to each side of the 16" x 22" Fabric **A** large panel. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 20" Fabric **B** strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric **A** large panel. Trim the block to measure 19" x 25" to make the **Center Block (Fig. 1)**.



2. Sew (1) 2" x 10-1/2" Fabric **B** strip to each side of (1) 10-1/2" Fabric **A** square. Sew (1) 2" x 13-1/2" Fabric **B** strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric **A** square. Trim the block to measure 12-1/2" square to make (1) **Unit 1 square (Fig. 2)**. Repeat to make (4) **Unit 1** squares total.



3. Place (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **C** square on the top left corner of (1) **Unit 1** square, right sides together (**Fig. 3**). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (**Fig. 3**). Flip open the triangle formed and press (**Fig. 4**). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.









5. Repeat **Steps 3-4** to make (4) **Unit 2** squares total.

6. Sew (1) 1-1/4" x 25" Fabric **E** strip to each side of (1) 6-1/2" x 25" Fabric **F** strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 2-3/4" x 25" Fabric **D** strip to each side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) **Side Border (Fig. 7)**. Repeat to make a second **Side Border**.



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7. Sew (1) 1-1/4" x 19" Fabric **E** strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 6-1/2" x 19" Fabric **F** strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 2-3/4" x 19" Fabric **D** strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) **Unit 2** square to each end of the new strip to make the **Top Border (Fig. 8)**. Repeat to make the **Bottom Border**.



## Quilt Top Assembly:

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the runner top.)*

8. Sew (1) **Side Border** to each side of the **Center Block**.


9. Sew the **Top Border** and **Bottom Border** to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

10. Sew (1) 6-1/4" x 49" Fabric **G** orange strip to each side of the **Center Block**.

11. Sew (1) 6-1/4" Fabric **H** square to each end of (1) 6-1/4" x 43" Fabric **G** purple strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using (6) Fabric **I** 2-1/2" strips.
