

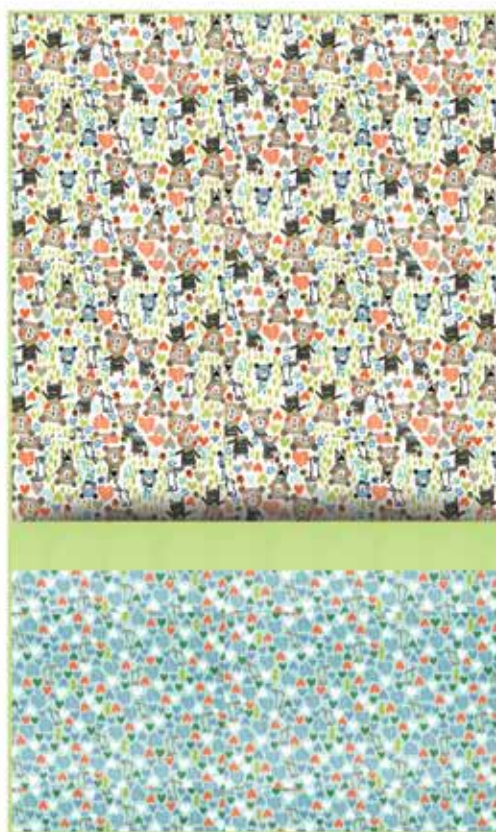

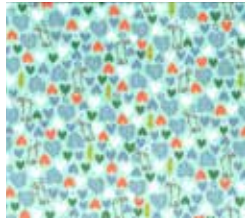

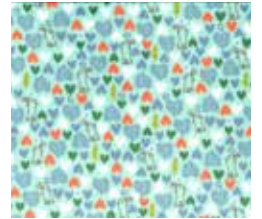

## "Bears & Bunnies Minky"

Design by Heidi Pridemore Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

Approximate Sizes – Quilt: 46" x 46", Heart Pillow: 20" x 21", Snuggle Blanket: 30" x 50", Pillowcase: 32" x 20"

### Materials

#### Cutting instructions

**Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. 1/2" seam allowance is used. Yardages are based on 58" wide fabric.**

Quilt	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	SMP8085-Forest Bears & Bunnies-Forest	5/8 yard	• See instructions to cut thirteen hearts.
(B)	SMP8086-Dawn Bunny Love-Dawn	1 3/8 yards	• Cut one 41" x 4" WOF strip. • Cut one 4" x 47" WOF strip. • See instructions to cut twelve hearts.
(C)	SMS7580-Bright Lime Cotton Couture-Bright Lime	7/8 yard	• Cut four 9" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirteen 9" squares. • Cut four 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
(D)	SMS7580-Off White Cotton Couture-Off White	7/8 yard	• Cut three 9" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 9" squares.
Backing	SMP8086-Dawn Bunny Love-Dawn	1 1/8 yards	• Cut two 54" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 54" pieced backing.

(A)	SMP8085-Forest Bears & Bunnies-Forest	3/4 yard	• Cut one Heart Pillow Template.
(B)	SMP8086-Dawn Bunny Love-Dawn	3/4 yard	• Cut one Heart Pillow Template.

Snuggle Blanket	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	SMP8085-Forest Bears & Bunnies-Forest	1 1/2 yards	• Cut one 51" x 31" WOF strip.
(B)	SMP8086-Dawn Bunny Love-Dawn	5/8 yard	• Cut two 17" x 31" WOF strips.
(C)	SMS7580-Bright Lime Cotton Couture-Bright Lime	1/2 yard	• Cut one 7" x 31" WOF strip. • Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
Backing	SMP8085-Forest Bears & Bunnies-Forest	1 3/8 yards	• Cut one 58" x 38" WOF strip.

Pillowcase	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	SMP8085-Forest Bears & Bunnies-Forest	2/3 yard	• Cut one 21" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 10" x 21" strips.
(B)	SMP8086-Dawn Bunny Love-Dawn	2/3 yard	• Cut one 21" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 11" x 21" strips.
(C)	SMS7580-Bright Lime Cotton Couture-Bright Lime	1/4 yard	• Cut two 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into four 3" x 21" strips.

#### You will also need:

- Poly-fill, fusible web, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Quilt Assembly

- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- Refer to Figure 1 to arrange and press one Fabric A heart onto one 9" Fabric C square.
- Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make one Block One square.
- Repeat Steps 3-4 to make thirteen Block One squares total.
- Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figure 2 to arrange and press one Fabric B heart onto each 9" Fabric D square to make twelve Block Two squares.

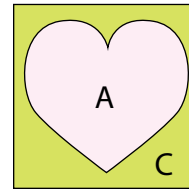

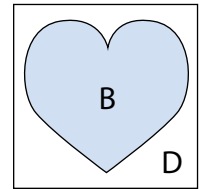

### Refer to Figure 3 when assembling the quilt top.

- Sew three Block One squares and two Block Two squares together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three and Five.
- Sew three Block Two squares and two Block One squares together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- Sew the five rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
- Sew one 4" x 41" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 4" x 47" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew the four 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.

Quilt Layout

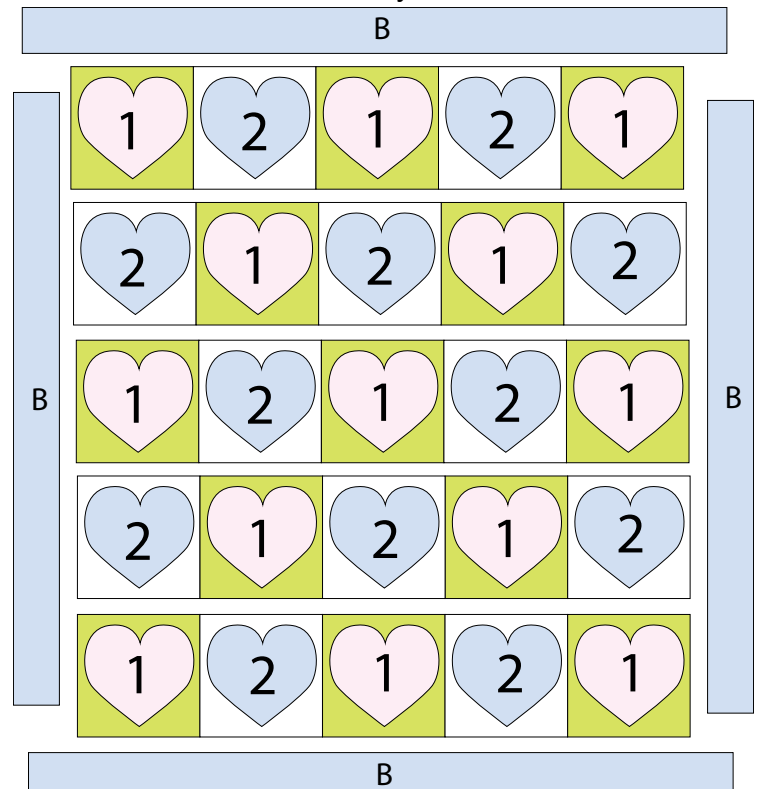

## Snuggle Blanket Assembly

14. Layer the 31" x 51" Fabric A piece with batting and quilt as desired (Fig. 4).
15. Sew one 17" x 31" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of one 7" x 31" Fabric C strip to make one BCB strip (Fig. 5).
16. Fold the BCB strip in half to make the pocket (Fig. 6).
17. Position and sew the pocket in place. Catch the edge of the edge of the pocket with the binding (Fig. 7).
18. Sew the three 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
19. Bind as desired.

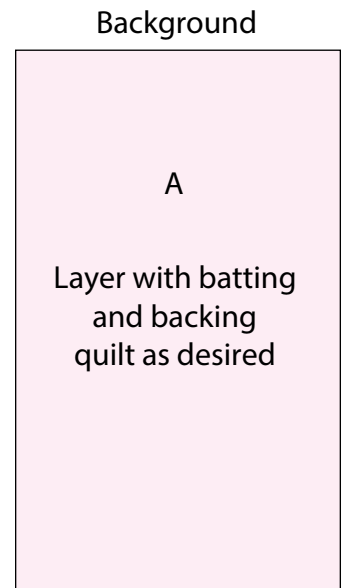

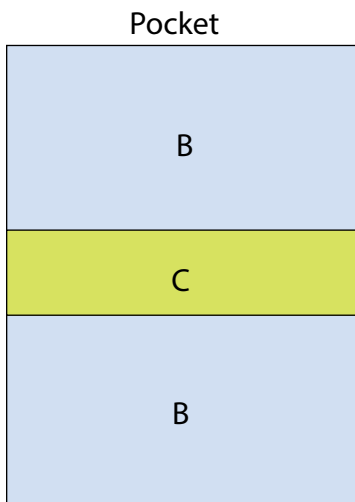

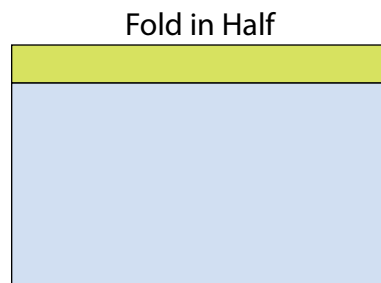

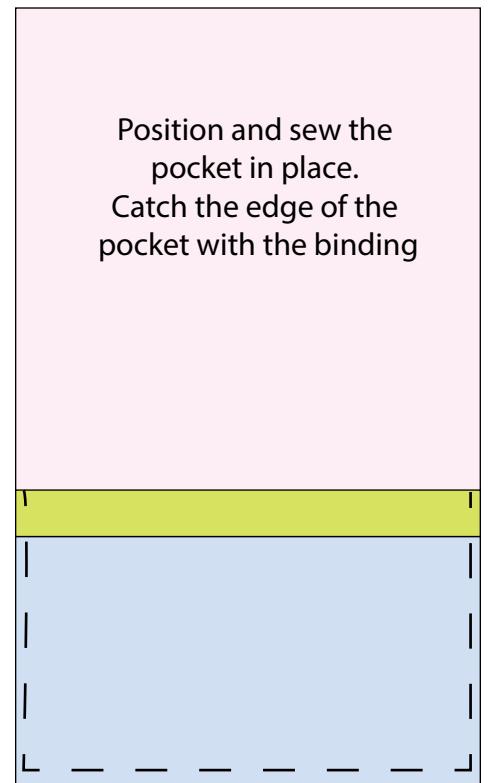

## Heart Pillow Assembly

20. Place the Fabric A heart and Fabric B heart right sides together. Stitch around the perimeter of the heart, leaving an opening for turning.
21. Turn the heart right side out and fill with poly-fill.
22. Stitch the opening closed to complete the Heart Pillow.

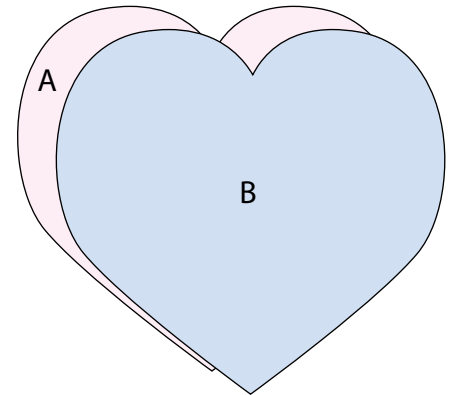

## Pillowcase Assembly

23. Sew one 3" x 21" Fabric C strip to each side of one 11" x 21" Fabric B strip. Sew one 10" x 21" Fabric A strip to each side of the sewn strip to make one Pillow Case panel (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Pillowcase panel.
24. Fold under and hem one short side of each Pillowcase panel (Fig. 10).
25. Place the two Pillowcase panels right sides together and sew together on the three remaining sides to make the Pillowcase (Fig. 11).
26. Turn the Pillowcase right side out to complete the Pillowcase.

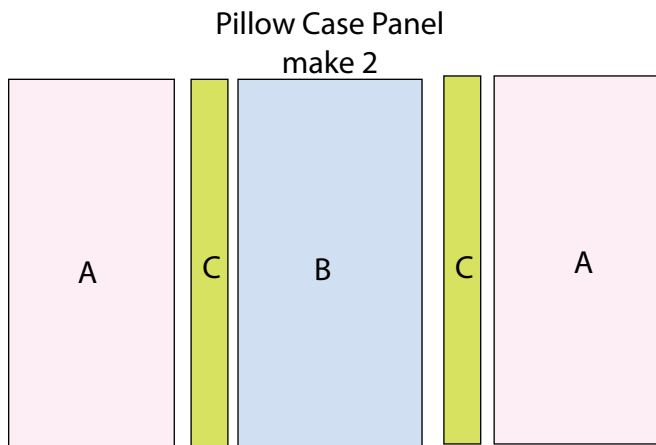

Fold under and hem one short side of each panel

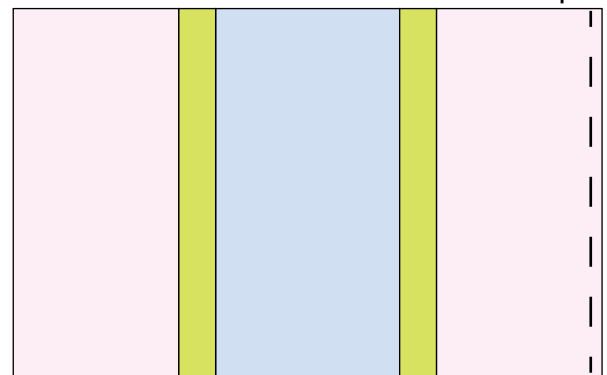
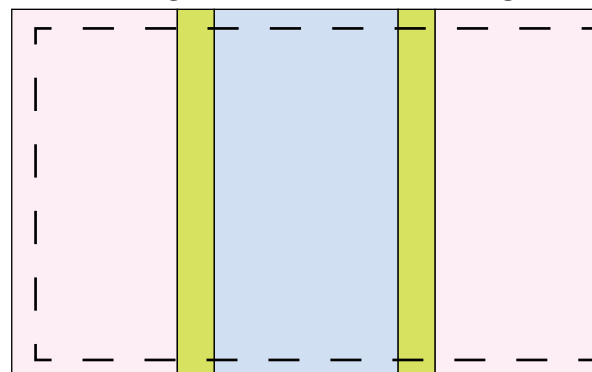


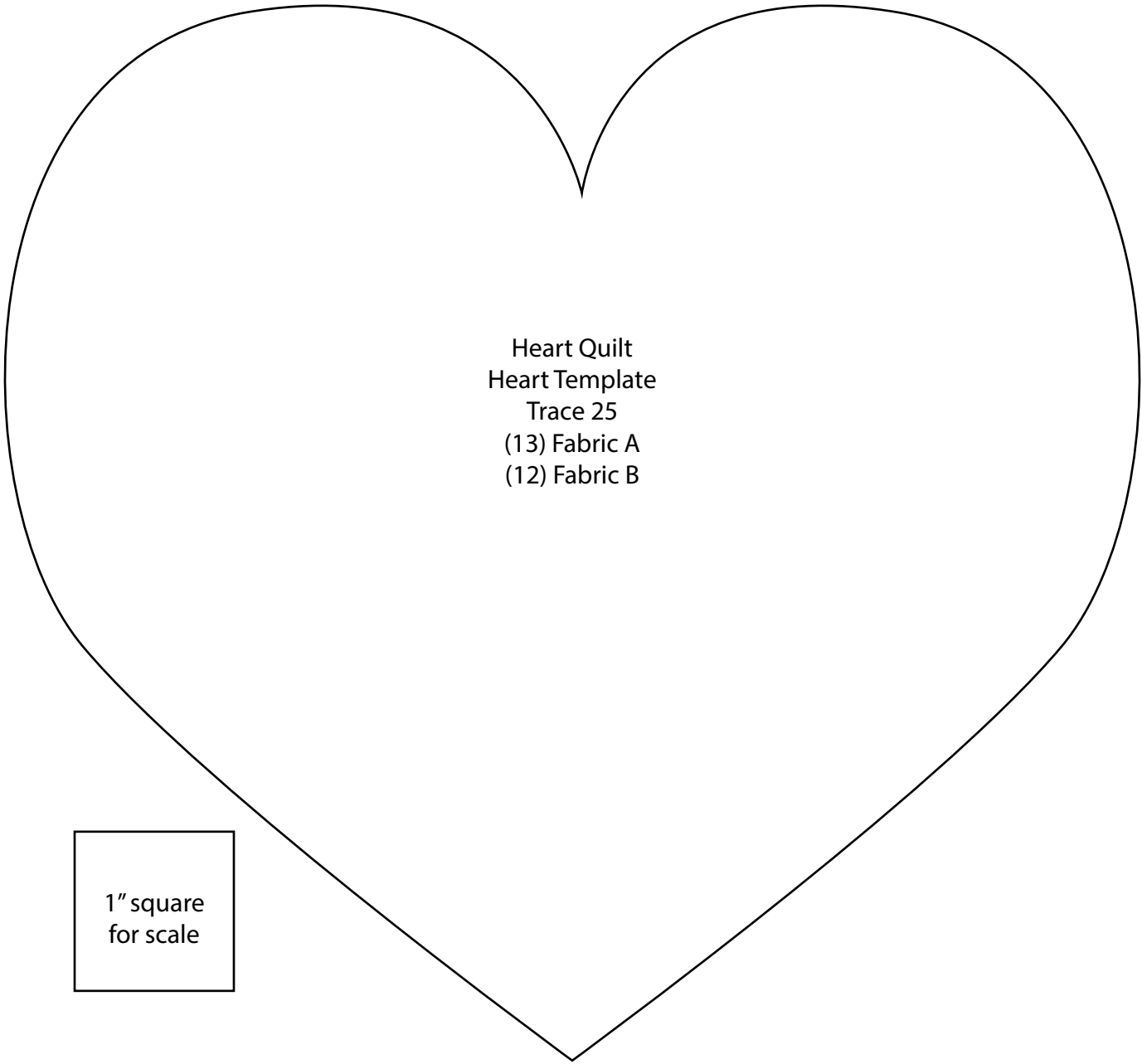

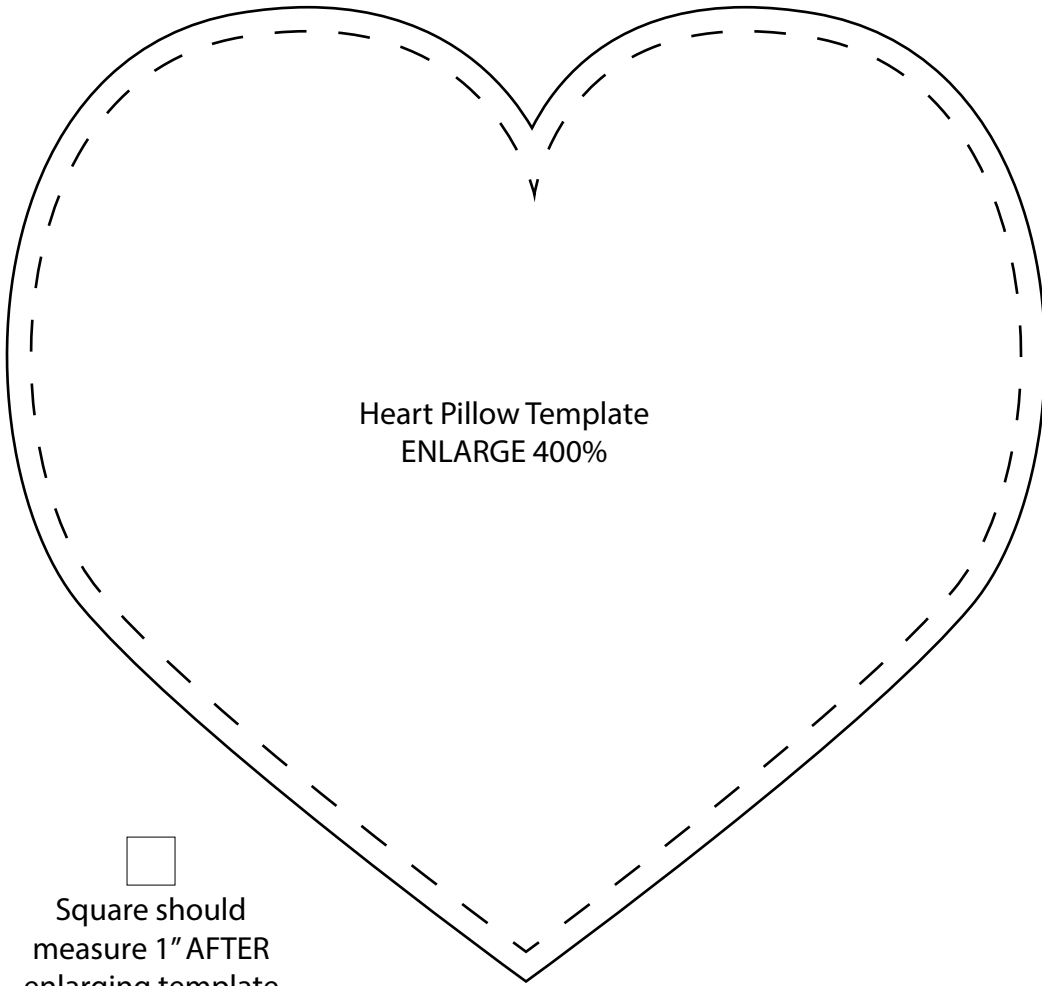
