


#### **CONSTRUCTING PIECED BLOCKS**

1. Sew (2) 1"  $\times$  6 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangles to the left and right sides of (1) 6 1/2"  $\times$  6 1/2" print square, followed by (2) 1"  $\times$  7 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangles to the top and bottom of the same 6 1/2"  $\times$  6 1/2" print square.



2. Sew (1) 2"  $\times$  3 1/2" **Fabric K** rectangle to the top, and (1) 2"  $\times$  3 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle to the bottom of (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  2" **Fabric A** rectangle to make a column unit. Column unit measures 2"  $\times$  7 1/2" raw edge to raw edge. Add column to the left of unit made in step 1.


Sew (1) 2"  $\times$  3 1/2" **Fabric G** rectangle to the top, and (1) 2"  $\times$  3 1/2" **Fabric J** rectangle to the bottom of (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  2" **Fabric A** rectangle to make a column unit. Add column to the right of unit made in step 1.



3. Sew (1) 2"  $\times$  5" **Fabric K** rectangle to the left, and (1) 2"  $\times$  5" **Fabric G** rectangle to the right of (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  2" **Fabric A** rectangle to make a row unit. Row unit measures 2"  $\times$  10 1/2" raw edge to raw edge. Add row to the top of unit made in step 2.

Sew (1) 2"  $\times$  5" **Fabric I** rectangle to the left and (1) 2"  $\times$  5" **Fabric J** rectangle to the right of (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  2" **Fabric A** rectangle to make a row unit. Add row to the bottom of unit made in step 2 to complete (1) pieced block.






4. Make a total number of blocks for the following **prints**:

5 blocks: **Fabric B**4 blocks: **Fabrics C, D**3 blocks: **Fabric H**2 blocks: **Fabrics E, F** 

#### **Quilt Center Assembly**

1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image for block placement guide, arrange and sew together (4) pieced blocks and (3) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" **Fabric A** sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (5) pieced rows. Row 1 is shown below.




2. Pieced sashing rows. Arrange and sew together (4) 1  $1/2" \times 10 1/2"$  **Fabric A** sashing rectangles and (3) 1  $1/2" \times 1 1/2"$  **Fabric L** squares to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (4) pieced sashing rows.



3. Sew together pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.





### **Quilt Top Assembly**

- 1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 2  $1/2" \times 54 \ 1/2"$  **Fabric A** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2  $1/2" \times 47 \ 1/2"$  **Fabric A** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 1  $1/2" \times 58 \ 1/2"$  **Fabric L** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1  $1/2" \times 49 \ 1/2"$  **Fabric L** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 3. Outer border. Sew (2) 3  $1/2" \times 60 1/2"$  **Fabric C** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3  $1/2" \times 55 1/2"$  **Fabric C** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.





### **Finishing**

- 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to finish quilt.
